Summary of Legislation

Under current law, the Board of County Commissioners (BOCC) is required to hold a formal hearing to certify, to the county assessor, the number of mills to be levied on taxable property in the county. This bill gives the BOCC the option to authorize these levies by written approval rather than by formal hearing and to delegate the certification process to staff or other authorized parties.

Local Government

The bill creates an alternative option for county commissioners and staff to certify mill levies, which may reduce or modify administrative costs. Counties choosing to allow certification by written approval instead of a formal hearing may see a reduction in staff time requirements. For counties choosing to delegate certification authority, staff time costs may be modified. Any impact is conditional on the county modifying its existing process.

Effective Date

The bill takes effect 90 days following adjournment of the General Assembly sine die, assuming no referendum petition is filed.
