**Future Fiscal Impact**

The bill identifies the receipt and use of gifts, grants, and donations for implementation. The bill requires a one-time expenditure of \$30,000 in FY 2026-27. If the necessary revenue from these sources is not realized, then the Department of Regulatory Agencies anticipates an annual increase of appropriations and expenditures of \$44,000, including 0.5 FTE, from the Division of Professions and Occupations Cash Fund, created in Section 12-20-105, C.R.S., beginning in FY 2027-28.
