Bill Topic: ELIMINATE OBSOLETE COMMITTEE CHILD CARE LICENSING

Summary of Fiscal Impact:

No fiscal impact. The bill removes obsolete language referencing an inactive

advisory committee in the Department of Human Services.

Appropriation Summary:

No appropriation is required.

Fiscal Note Status:

The fiscal note reflects the introduced bill, which is recommended by the Statutory

Revision Committee.

Summary of Legislation

The bill eliminates an obsolete advisory committee that assisted the Department of Human Services with the licensing of child care facilities prior to the creation of the Early Childhood Leadership Commission.

Assessment of No Fiscal Impact

This advisory committee has been inactive since the creation of the Early Childhood Leadership Commission, which assumed the advisory role related to child care facilities. The advisory committee has no associated revenue or costs under current law, and the bill strikes obsolete language from state statute. For these reasons, the bill is assessed as having no fiscal impact.

Effective Date

The bill takes effect 90 days following adjournment of the General Assembly sine die, assuming no referendum petition is filed.
