A BILL FOR AN ACT

101 CONCERNING A TRANSFER FROM THE GENERAL FUND TO THE  
102 LICENSING SERVICES CASH FUND.

---

Bill Summary

*(Note: This summary applies to this bill as introduced and does not reflect any amendments that may be subsequently adopted. The bill requires the state treasurer to transfer \$3,900,000 from the general fund to the licensing services cash fund. This transfer allows the department to maintain the current driver license fee while supporting the solvency of the cash fund.

1 *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:*

2 **SECTION 1. Legislative declaration.** (1) The general assembly  
3 hereby finds and declares that:

4 (a) The current fee for a driver license or minor's driver license fee  
5 is set at thirty dollars and eighty-seven cents;

6 (b) The department of revenue has the authority to raise or lower  
7 driver license or minor's driver license fees and is projecting the need to  
8 increase driver license fees for the upcoming two years to maintain the  
9 existing level of service to Coloradans;

10 (c) In order to avoid the department from increasing the driver  
11 license fee by an additional two dollars to maintain the existing level of  
12 service to Coloradans, the general assembly finds it necessary to transfer  
13 three million nine hundred thousand dollars in funds from the general  
14 fund into the licensing services cash fund;

15 (d) Notwithstanding the projected deficit in the future, the  
16 transferred funds will support the current solvency needs of the licensing  
17 services cash fund; and

18 (e) Transferring these funds from the general fund to the licensing  
19 services cash fund will ensure the department has the funding necessary  
20 to maintain the current driver license fee and support the solvency of the  
21 cash fund.

22 **SECTION 2.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 42-2-114.5, **add** (5)  
23 as follows:

24 **42-2-114.5. Licensing services cash fund - fee setting**  
25 **procedures - rules.** (5) ON JULY 1, 2022, THE STATE TREASURER SHALL  
26 TRANSFER THREE MILLION NINE HUNDRED THOUSAND DOLLARS FROM THE  
27 GENERAL FUND TO THE LICENSING SERVICES CASH FUND.

1           **SECTION 3. Safety clause.** The general assembly hereby finds,  
2 determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate  
3 preservation of the public peace, health, or safety.
