# A BILL FOR AN ACT

101 CONCERNING INCREASED FUNDING FOR THE DIVISION OF WATER 102 RESOURCES FROM THE OPERATIONAL ACCOUNT OF THE 103 SEVERANCE TAX TRUST FUND.

## **Bill Summary**

Water Resources Review Committee. Authorizes the expenditure of up to 5% of the moneys in tier 1 of the operational account of the severance tax trust fund for the division of water resources, and allows this increase to supplant moneys that would otherwise be made

available to the division from the general fund. Eliminates the tier 1 authorization for the division of wildlife to account for the increase.

1 Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado: 2 **SECTION 1.** 39-29-109.3 (1) (e), Colorado Revised Statutes, is 3 amended, and the said 39-29-109.3 (1) is further amended BY THE 4 ADDITION OF A NEW PARAGRAPH, to read: 5 39-29-109.3. Operational account of the severance tax trust 6 **fund - repeal.** (1) For fiscal years commencing on and after July 1, 7 1997, the executive director of the department of natural resources shall 8 submit with the department's budget request for each fiscal year a list and 9 description of the programs the executive director recommends to be 10 funded from the operational account of the severance tax trust fund 11 created in section 39-29-109 (2) (b), referred to in this section as the 12 "operational account". The minerals, energy, and geology policy advisory 13 board established pursuant to section 34-20-104, C.R.S., shall review the 14 executive director's recommendation before submittal. The general 15 assembly may appropriate moneys from the total moneys available in the 16 operational account to fund recommended programs as follows: 17 (e) For fiscal years commencing on or after July 1, 2008, only, for 18 programs within the division of wildlife that monitor, manage, or mitigate 19 the impacts of mineral or mineral fuel production activities on wildlife in 20 any region of the state in which production activity is occurring or, from 21 any location in the state, research such impacts, up to five percent of the 22 moneys in the operational account, which moneys shall not supplant 23 moneys that would otherwise be made available for such programs; 24 (g) FOR FISCAL YEARS COMMENCING ON OR AFTER JULY 1, 2010, 25 FOR PROGRAMS WITHIN THE DIVISION OF WATER RESOURCES, UP TO FIVE
