101	CONCERNING THE CREATION OF A SEABEES LICENSE PLATE TO HONOR
102	THE SEABEES TRADITION, AND, IN CONNECTION THEREWITH
103	MAKING AN APPROPRIATION.

# **Bill Summary**

The bill creates the Seabees license plate. In addition to the standard motor vehicle fees, the plate requires 2 one-time fees of \$25. One fee is credited to the highway users tax fund and the other to a fund that provides licensing services.

1	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:
2	SECTION 1. Legislative declaration. The Colorado General
3	Assembly hereby recognizes the unique role that the United States Naval
4	Construction Battalions serve in the nation's armed forces. This act
5	creates a commemorative license plate to honor the service of Seabees
6	veterans. The Seabees take their name from United States Naval
7	Construction Battalions, or "CBs". Since World War II, the Seabees have
8	provided essential engineering and construction services prior to and
9	during combat all over the globe. Their ingenuity and dedication have
10	made critical differences in combat efforts from Normandy and Okinawa
11	to Iraq and Afghanistan. They have a "can do" attitude and ability to drop
12	their tools and take up arms to fight. They have been a dependable force
13	for more than 75 years and continue to serve our nation. Seabees service
14	people have a motto: "We build, we fight".
15	SECTION 2. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 42-3-213, add
16	(1)(a)(XXIX) and (30) as follows:
17	42-3-213. License plates - military veterans - rules -
18	<b>retirement.</b> (1) (a) The department shall issue one or more sets of license
19	plates to the following persons who own a truck that does not exceed
20	sixteen thousand pounds empty weight, a passenger car, a motorcycle, or
21	a noncommercial or recreational vehicle:
22	(XXIX) AN HONORABLY DISCHARGED, RETIRED, RESERVE, OR
23	ACTIVE MEMBER OF A CONSTRUCTION BATTALION OF THE UNITED STATES
24	NAVY.
25	(30) Honorably discharged, retired veteran, or active member
26	of the Seabees. (a) BEGINNING JANUARY 1, 2019, THE DEPARTMENT

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1	SHALL DESIGN THE SEABEES LICENSE PLATE TO INDICATE THAT AN OWNER
2	OF A MOTOR VEHICLE TO WHICH THE PLATE IS ATTACHED IS A VETERAN,
3	RESERVE MEMBER, OR ACTIVE MEMBER OF A CONSTRUCTION BATTALION
4	OF THE UNITED STATES NAVY.
5	(b) A NATURAL PERSON WHO HAS RECEIVED AN HONORABLE
6	DISCHARGE, IS RETIRED, OR IS AN ACTIVE OR RESERVE MEMBER OF ANY
7	CONSTRUCTION BATTALION OF THE UNITED STATES NAVY MAY USE A
8	SEABEES LICENSE PLATE.
9	(c) TO QUALIFY FOR A SEABEES LICENSE PLATE, AN APPLICANT
10	MUST SUBMIT A DD214 FORM ISSUED BY THE UNITED STATES
11	GOVERNMENT OR OTHER EVIDENCE SUFFICIENT TO DEMONSTRATE THAT
12	THE APPLICANT IS A VETERAN, RESERVE MEMBER, OR ACTIVE MEMBER OF
13	A CONSTRUCTION BATTALION OF THE UNITED STATES NAVY.
