101 **CONCERNING THE ADDITION OF REPRESENTATIVES FROM NATIVE**
102 **AMERICAN TRIBES WITH RESERVATIONS IN COLORADO TO THE**
103 **COLORADO YOUTH ADVISORY COUNCIL.**

Bill Summary

The bill adds 2 voting positions to the Colorado youth advisory council for representatives from the Southern Ute tribe and the Ute Mountain Ute tribe.

1 *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:*

2 **SECTION 1.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 2-2-1303, **amend**
3 (1)(b) introductory portion and (1)(b)(II) as follows:

4 **2-2-1303. Membership - selection - terms.** (1) The council
5 consists of forty-four members as follows:

6 (b) Thirty-five voting members representing each senate district
7 in the state, ~~and five~~ ONE VOTING MEMBER REPRESENTING THE SOUTHERN
8 UTE TRIBE, ONE VOTING MEMBER REPRESENTING THE UTE MOUNTAIN UTE
9 TRIBE, AND THREE NONVOTING at-large members. The ~~five~~ THREE at-large
10 members must be selected to help ensure diversity on the council, with an
11 express concern for adequate rural representation. Members described in
12 this ~~paragraph (b)~~ SUBSECTION (1)(b) must meet the following
13 qualifications at the time of appointment:

14 (II) Be enrolled in and attending a Colorado junior high, middle,
15 or high school, including an online or charter school or approved facility
16 school as defined in section 22-2-402; ~~C.R.S.~~; be participating in a
17 nonpublic, home-based educational program; be participating in a high
18 school equivalency examination program; or have obtained a high school
19 diploma through successful completion of a high school equivalency
20 examination, as defined in section 22-33-102 (8.5). ~~C.R.S.~~

21 **SECTION 2. Safety clause.** The general assembly hereby finds,
22 determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate
23 preservation of the public peace, health, or safety.
