# A BILL FOR AN ACT

101	<b>CONCERNING THE PREPARATION BY THE DIVISION OF HOUSING WITHIN</b>
102	THE DEPARTMENT OF LOCAL AFFAIRS OF AN ANNUAL PUBLIC
103	REPORT THAT PROVIDES INFORMATION ON MONEY

### **Bill Summary**

Not later than October 1, 2021, and not later than October 1 of each year thereafter, the bill requires the division of housing (division) in

SENATE Amended 2nd Reading May 21, 2021 the department of local affairs to prepare a public report that specifies the total amount of money that:

- The division or the state housing board (board) received from any federal, state, other public, or any private source during the prior fiscal year; and
- The division or the board expended from state funding during the prior fiscal year to make an award in the form of a grant or loan to promote the provision of affordable housing.

The bill identifies various items the report must address. The report shall be posted on the division's website and shared with the board and the general assembly.

1 Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado: 2 SECTION 1. In Colorado Revised Statutes, add 24-32-705.5 as 3 follows: 4 24-32-705.5. Annual public report on funding of affordable 5 housing preservation and production - definition. (1) "COMMENCING 6 IN 2021 AND EVERY YEAR THEREAFTER, AS PART OF THE DEPARTMENT'S 7 PRESENTATION TO ITS JOINT COMMITTEES OF REFERENCE AT A HEARING 8 HELD PURSUANT TO SECTION 2-7-203 (2)(a) OF THE "STATE 9 MEASUREMENT FOR ACCOUNTABLE, RESPONSIVE, AND TRANSPARENT 10 (SMART) GOVERNMENT ACT", IN ACCORDANCE WITH THIS SECTION, THE 11 DIVISION SHALL PREPARE A PUBLIC REPORT THAT SPECIFIES THE TOTAL 12 AMOUNT OF MONEY THAT: 13 (a) THE DIVISION OR THE BOARD WAS APPROPRIATED, AWARDED, 14 ALLOCATED, OR TRANSFERRED FROM ANY FEDERAL, STATE, OTHER PUBLIC, 15 OR ANY PRIVATE SOURCE DURING THE PRIOR FISCAL YEAR THAT MAY BE 16 USED FOR THE PRESERVATION OR PRODUCTION OF EMERGENCY OR 17 AFFORDABLE HOUSING; AND 18 THE DIVISION OR THE BOARD HAS AWARDED FROM ANY (b) 19 FEDERAL, STATE, OTHER PUBLIC, OR ANY PRIVATE SOURCE DURING THE PRIOR FISCAL YEAR IN THE FORM OF A GRANT, CONTRACT, OR LOAN TO
 PROMOTE THE PRESERVATION OR PRODUCTION OF EMERGENCY OR
 AFFORDABLE HOUSING.

4 (c) THE DIVISION EXPENDED DURING THE PRIOR FISCAL YEAR ON 5 ADMINISTRATIVE COSTS ASSOCIATED WITH EACH FUNDING SOURCE 6 IDENTIFIED IN SUBSECTION (1)(a) OF THIS SECTION AND THE NUMBER OF 7 FULL-TIME EMPLOYEES SUPPORTED BY THE FUNDING SOURCE IDENTIFIED. 8 (2) WITH RESPECT TO ANY FUNDING AWARD MADE BY THE 9 DIVISION OR THE BOARD TO PROMOTE THE PRESERVATION OR PRODUCTION 10 OF EMERGENCY OR AFFORDABLE HOUSING IN THE FORM OF A GRANT OR 11 LOAN, THE REPORT MUST IDENTIFY THE: 12 (a) APPLICANT FOR THE AWARD; 13 (b) NAME OF THE PROJECT BEING FUNDED BY THE AWARD; 14 (c) SOURCE OF THE AWARD FUNDING FOR THE PROJECT; 15 (d) AMOUNT OF AWARD FUNDING THAT WAS REQUESTED FOR THE 16 PROJECT IDENTIFIED AT THE TIME THE FINAL APPLICATION WAS 17 SUBMITTED;

18 (e) AMOUNT OF FUNDING AWARDED THROUGH THE GRANT OR19 LOAN;

20 (f) TOTAL COST OF THE ENTIRE PROJECT BEING FUNDED BY THE21 AWARD;

(g) MUNICIPALITY AND COUNTY IN WHICH THE PROJECT BEINGFUNDED BY THE AWARD IS LOCATED;

24 (h) TYPE OF HOUSING SOLUTION BEING FUNDED BY THE AWARD,
25 SUCH AS HOMEOWNERSHIP, RENTAL, EMERGENCY, OR AFFORDABLE
26 HOUSING;

27 (i) PURPOSE OF THE AWARD, SUCH AS NEW CONSTRUCTION OF

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HOUSING, PRESERVATION OF EXISTING HOUSING, DOWN PAYMENT
 ASSISTANCE, LAND ACQUISITION, OR REPAIRS OF OWNER-OCCUPIED
 HOUSING; AND

4 (j) NUMBER OF HOUSING UNITS BUILT, ACQUIRED, REHABILITATED,
5 OR PRESERVED BY THE AWARD.

6 (3) EACH REPORT MUST ALSO PROVIDE A SUMMARY DESCRIBING
7 THE SOURCE AND AMOUNT OF ALL FUNDING APPROPRIATED,
8 RE-APPROPRIATED, TRANSFERRED, OR OTHERWISE MADE AVAILABLE TO
9 THE DIVISION OF HOUSING THAT MAY BE USED FOR THE PRESERVATION OR
10 PRODUCTION OF EMERGENCY OR AFFORDABLE HOUSING.

12 (4) THE DIVISION SHALL POST THE MOST RECENT VERSION OF THE 13 ANNUAL PUBLIC REPORT IT HAS PREPARED AS REQUIRED UNDER 14 SUBSECTION (1) OF THIS SECTION IN A PROMINENT PLACE ON THE 15 DIVISION'S WEBSITE. IN ADDITION, ON AN ANNUAL BASIS, THE DIVISION 16 SHALL DELIVER A COPY OF THE MOST RECENT VERSION OF THE REPORT TO 17 THE BOARD AS WELL AS TO THE JOINT COMMITTEES OF REFERENCE FOR 18 PURPOSES OF THE HEARING HELD PURSUANT TO SECTION 2-7-203 (2)(a) OF 19 THE "STATE MEASUREMENT FOR ACCOUNTABLE, RESPONSIVE, AND 20 TRANSPARENT (SMART) GOVERNMENT ACT.

(5) NOTWITHSTANDING SECTION 24-1-136 (11)(a)(I), THE
REQUIREMENT TO SUBMIT THE REPORT REQUIRED BY SUBSECTION (1) OF
THIS SECTION CONTINUES INDEFINITELY.

(6) AS USED IN THIS SECTION, "AFFORDABLE HOUSING" MEANS ANY
CURRENT OR PROSPECTIVE STRUCTURE THAT HAS BENEFITTED FROM, OR
THAT MAY BENEFIT FROM, THE AWARD OF A PLACE-BASED GRANT OR LOAN
BY THE DIVISION. FOR PURPOSES OF THIS SECTION, "AFFORDABLE

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HOUSING" INCLUDES PERMANENT RESIDENCES, SUCH AS RENTAL OR
 FOR-SALE HOUSING INHABITED BY LOW-, MODERATE-, AND MIDDLE INCOME HOUSEHOLDS, AS WELL AS TEMPORARY AND EMERGENCY HOUSING
 SUCH AS TRANSITIONAL HOUSING AND SHELTERS AND HOUSEHOLDS THAT
 WILL BENEFIT FROM DOWN PAYMENT ASSISTANCE.

6 SECTION 2. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 24-32-705, add
7 (1)(v) as follows:

8 24-32-705. Functions of division. (1) The division has the
9 following functions:

10 (v) TO PREPARE AN ANNUAL PUBLIC REPORT ON FUNDING OF 11 AFFORDABLE HOUSING PRESERVATION AND PRODUCTION IN ACCORDANCE 12 WITH SECTION 24-32-705.5 AND TO SATISFY OTHER REQUIREMENTS IN 13 SECTION 24-32-705.5 PERTAINING TO THE PREPARATION AND 14 DISSEMINATION OF THE REPORT. IN ITS PRESENTATION TO THE JOINT 15 COMMITTEES OF REFERENCE PURSUANT TO SECTION 2-7-203, THE 16 DEPARTMENT SHALL SUMMARIZE THE INFORMATION CONTAINED IN THE 17 REPORT CONCERNING AFFORDABLE HOUSING FUNDING ADMINISTERED BY 18 THE DIVISION SINCE THE DEPARTMENT'S PRIOR PRESENTATION.

SECTION 3. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 24-32-721, amend
(3)(b) as follows:

21 24-32-721. Colorado affordable housing construction grants
22 and loans - housing development grant fund - creation - housing
23 assistance for persons with behavioral, mental health, or substance
24 use disorders - cash fund - appropriation - report to general assembly
25 - rules - definitions - repeal. (3) (b) Notwithstanding any other
26 provision of this section, the division, in its discretion, may transfer
27 twenty percent of the balance of the money in the fund into the housing

investment trust fund established in section 24-32-717 (1)(a), which
balance is calculated as of July 1 of the state fiscal year in which the
money is transferred. For any given state fiscal year, no more than three
percent of the money appropriated OR TRANSFERRED to the fund may be
expended for the administrative costs of the division in administering the
fund.

SECTION 4. No appropriation. The general assembly has
 determined that this act can be implemented within existing
 appropriations, and therefore no separate appropriation of state money is
 necessary to carry out the purposes of this act.

11 **SECTION 5.** Act subject to petition - effective date. This act 12 takes effect at 12:01 a.m. on the day following the expiration of the 13 ninety-day period after final adjournment of the general assembly; except 14 that, if a referendum petition is filed pursuant to section 1 (3) of article V 15 of the state constitution against this act or an item, section, or part of this 16 act within such period, then the act, item, section, or part will not take 17 effect unless approved by the people at the general election to be held in 18 November 2022 and, in such case, will take effect on the date of the 19 official declaration of the vote thereon by the governor.
