**A BILL FOR AN ACT**

101 **CONCERNING THE REPEAL OF THE FEE FOR THE BRANCH OF SERVICE**  
102 **IDENTIFIER ON COLORADO DRIVER'S LICENSES.**

**Bill Summary**

**Transportation Legislation Review Committee.** The bill repeals the fee currently charged to a member of the armed services for the branch of service identifier on a Colorado driver's license.

1 *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:*

2 **SECTION 1.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 42-2-114, **repeal** (10)  
3 (b) as follows:

4 **42-2-114. License issued - fees.** (10) (b) ~~(F) To be issued a~~  
5 ~~driver's license bearing a branch of service identifier, or to have such~~  
6 ~~license renewed, the applicant shall pay a fee of fifteen dollars to the~~  
7 ~~department, which shall be in addition to any other fee for a driver's~~  
8 ~~license. The department shall transfer the fee to the state treasurer, who~~  
9 ~~shall credit the fee to the highway users tax fund, except as provided in~~  
10 ~~subparagraph (H) of this paragraph (b).~~

11 ~~(H) (A) The department may retain up to ninety-eight thousand~~  
12 ~~five hundred thirty-eight dollars of the fees collected pursuant to~~  
13 ~~subparagraph (I) of this paragraph (b) as necessary to offset the direct and~~  
14 ~~indirect cost of implementing this subsection (10).~~

15 ~~(B) This subparagraph (H) is repealed, effective July 1, 2012.~~

16 **SECTION 2.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 42-2-303, **repeal** (4)  
17 (b) as follows:

18 **42-2-303. Contents of identification card.** (4) (b) ~~To be issued~~  
19 ~~an identification card bearing a branch of service identifier, or to have~~  
20 ~~such license renewed, the applicant shall pay a fee of fifteen dollars to the~~  
21 ~~department, which shall be in addition to any other fee for an~~  
22 ~~identification card. The department shall transfer the fee to the state~~  
23 ~~treasurer, who shall credit the fee to the highway users tax fund.~~

24 **SECTION 3. Safety clause.** The general assembly hereby finds,  
25 determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate  
26 preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
