A BILL FOR AN ACT

101 CONCERNING THE HOME- AND COMMUNITY-BASED SERVICES PROGRAM
102 FOR PERSONS WITH A BRAIN INJURY.

Bill Summary

For medicaid recipients receiving services under the home- and community-based services program for persons with a brain injury, the bill removes the nonmedical requirement for transitional living.

1 *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:*

2 **SECTION 1.** 25.5-6-703 (10), Colorado Revised Statutes, is
3 amended to read:

4 **25.5-6-703. Definitions.** As used in this part 7, unless the context
5 otherwise requires:

6 (10) "Transitional living" means a ~~nonmedical~~ residential program
7 that provides training and twenty-four-hour supervision to a recipient
8 over a six-to-twelve-month period that will enhance the recipient's ability
9 to live more independently.

10 **SECTION 2. Safety clause.** The general assembly hereby finds,
11 determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate
12 preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
