A BILL FOR AN ACT

101 CONCERNING A CHANGE OF THE DEFINITION OF "SALVAGE VEHICLE"  
102 TO INCLUDE MOTOR VEHICLES CURRENTLY EXCLUDED.

Bill Summary

Currently, a motor vehicle rebuilt from salvage must comply with several requirements to qualify for a certificate of title, such as stamping on the vehicle's frame the phrase "REBUILT FROM SALVAGE" and obtaining a VIN inspection. The bill changes the definition of "salvage vehicle" to include vehicles that are over 6 years old and applies the

requirements to those vehicles.

1 *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:*

2 **SECTION 1.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 42-6-102, **repeal** (17)

3 (c) as follows:

4 **42-6-102. Definitions.** As used in this part 1, unless the context  
5 otherwise requires:

6 (17) (c) ~~This subsection (17) shall not apply to a vehicle whose~~  
7 ~~model year of manufacture is six years or older at the time of damage.~~

8 **SECTION 2. Effective date - applicability.** This act takes effect  
9 July 1, 2012, and applies to acts committed on or after said date.

10 **SECTION 3. Safety clause.** The general assembly hereby finds,  
11 determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate  
12 preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
