CONCERNING THE AUTHORITY OF THE COMMISSIONER OF INSURANCE TO ADOPT RULES TO ENSURE CONSISTENT REQUIREMENTS FOR PEDIATRIC DENTAL BENEFITS IN HEALTH BENEFIT PLANS OFFERED IN COLORADO REGARDLESS OF THE METHOD BY WHICH A PLAN IS PURCHASED.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:

SECTION 1. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 10-16-103.4, **amend** (7) as follows:

10-16-103.4. Essential health benefits - requirements - rules. (7) The commissioner may adopt rules as necessary for the implementation and administration of this section AND TO ENSURE CONSISTENT REQUIREMENTS FOR PEDIATRIC DENTAL BENEFITS UNDER THIS SECTION REGARDLESS OF THE METHOD BY WHICH A HEALTH BENEFIT PLAN IS PURCHASED.

SECTION 2. Safety clause. The general assembly hereby finds, determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
