## A BILL FOR AN ACT

101	CONCERNING WAIVER OF THE REQUIREMENT THAT A HIRING SCHOOL
102	DISTRICT GRANT NONPROBATIONARY STATUS TO A TEACHER
103	WITH EFFECTIVE RATINGS WHO HAS OBTAINED
104	NONPROBATIONARY STATUS IN ANOTHER SCHOOL DISTRICT.

## **Bill Summary**

(Note: This summary applies to this bill as introduced and does not reflect any amendments that may be subsequently adopted. Under current law, if a teacher who has nonprobationary status in one school district applies to teach in another school district and the

teacher can show 2 years of positive effectiveness ratings on his or her performance evaluations, the new school district can hire the teacher only if it gives him or her nonprobationary status. The bill allows the teacher to waive this requirement so that the new school district can hire the teacher and give him or her probationary status.

1 *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:* 

- 2 **SECTION 1.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, amend 22-63-203.5 3 as follows:

**22-63-203.5.** Nonprobationary portability. (1) Beginning with 5 the 2014-15 school year, a nonprobationary teacher, except for a 6 nonprobationary teacher who has had two consecutive performance 7 evaluations with an ineffective rating, who is employed by a school district and is subsequently hired by a different school district may 8 9 provide to the hiring school district evidence of his or her student 10 academic growth data and performance evaluations for the prior two 11 years for the purposes of retaining nonprobationary status. If, upon 12 providing such THE data, the nonprobationary teacher can show two 13 consecutive performance evaluations with effectiveness ratings in good 14 standing, he or she shall be granted THE HIRING SCHOOL DISTRICT SHALL 15 GRANT THE TEACHER nonprobationary status in the hiring school district. 16 (2) NOTWITHSTANDING THE PROVISIONS OF SUBSECTION (1) OF 17 THIS SECTION, A NONPROBATIONARY TEACHER MAY WAIVE THE 18 PROVISIONS OF THIS SECTION, IN WHICH CASE THE SCHOOL DISTRICT MAY 19 GRANT THE TEACHER PROBATIONARY STATUS IN THE HIRING SCHOOL
