Bill Summary

The bill designates the deputy executive director of the department of public safety and the director of the division of criminal justice in the department of public safety as peace officers who may be certified by the peace officer standards and training board. 17	DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY, PURSUANT TO SECTION 13 OF ARTICLE
18	XII OF THE STATE CONSTITUTION. SUBJECT TO THE SUPERVISION OF THE
19	EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR, THE DEPUTY DIRECTOR HAS THE SAME POWERS,
20	DUTIES, AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR AS PROVIDED
21	BY LAW AND SHALL EXERCISE SUCH POWERS, DUTIES, AND
22	RESPONSIBILITIES IN THE ABSENCE OF THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR AND
