### A BILL FOR AN ACT

101 **CONCERNING THE COLLECTION OF MAIL BALLOTS.** 

#### **Bill Summary**

(Note: This summary applies to this bill as introduced and does not reflect any amendments that may be subsequently adopted. Section 1 of the bill changes the required designated number of voter service and polling centers (VSPC) for counties with at least 25,000 active electors:

- ! During early voting, from at least one VSPC for each 30,000 active electors to at least one VSPC for each 75,000 active electors; and
- ! On election day, from at least one VSPC for each 15,000 active electors to at least one VSPC for each 30,000 active

#### electors.

**Section 2** of the bill deletes a requirement in the "Colorado Local Government Election Code" requiring the return envelope for a mail ballot packet to have a flap covering the signature.

1 Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado: 2 **SECTION 1.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 1-5-102.9, **amend** (1) 3 (a) (I) as follows: 4 1-5-102.9. Voter service and polling centers - number required 5 - services provided - drop-off locations - repeal. (1) (a) For general 6 elections, each county clerk and recorder shall designate a minimum 7 number of voter service and polling centers, as follows: 8 (I) For counties with at least twenty-five thousand active electors: 9 (A) During the period designated for early voting, at least one 10 voter service and polling center for each thirty SEVENTY-FIVE thousand 11 active electors; except that there must be at least one voter service and 12 polling center in each such county; and 13 (B) On election day, at least one voter service and polling center 14 for every fifteen THIRTY thousand active electors, but no fewer than three 15 in each such county. 16 **SECTION 2.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 1-13.5-1105, repeal (4) (c) (III) as follows: 17 18 1-13.5-1105. Procedures for conducting independent mail 19 **ballot election.** (4) (c) (III) The return envelope is required to have a flap 20 covering the signature. 21 SECTION 3. Act subject to petition - effective date -22 **applicability.** (1) This act takes effect at 12:01 a.m. on the day following 23 the expiration of the ninety-day period after final adjournment of the

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general assembly (August 5, 2015, if adjournment sine die is on May 6,
2015); except that, if a referendum petition is filed pursuant to section 1
(3) of article V of the state constitution against this act or an item, section,
or part of this act within such period, then the act, item, section, or part
will not take effect unless approved by the people at the general election
to be held in November 2016 and, in such case, will take effect on the
date of the official declaration of the vote thereon by the governor.

8 (2) This act applies to elections conducted on or after the 9 applicable effective date of this act.
