A BILL FOR AN ACT

101 CONCERNING THE ANNUAL DATE FOR ESTABLISHING THE TOTAL PUPIL
102 ENROLLMENT OF EACH PUBLIC SCHOOL.

Bill Summary

(Note: This summary applies to this bill as introduced and does not reflect any amendments that may be subsequently adopted. If this bill passes third reading in the house of introduction, a bill summary that applies to the reengrossed version of this bill will be available at http://www.leg.state.co.us/billsummaries.)

For the purpose of determining the pupil enrollment count of each public school of the state, the bill defines "pupil enrollment count day" as October 1 of each year, with the following exceptions:

In any year in which October 1 is a Saturday, a Sunday, or any other day on which school is not in session, the pupil

- enrollment count day is the Monday following that Saturday, Sunday, or other day; and
- ! In any year in which a day of a major religious holiday occurs upon October 1, or, in years in which October 1 falls on a Saturday, Sunday, or other day on which school is not in session, or upon the Monday directly following October 1, the pupil enrollment count day is the first school day immediately following the conclusion of the holiday.

The bill replaces existing statutory references to "October 1" with "pupil enrollment count day" as needed.
