A BILL FOR AN ACT

101 CONCERNING RESTRICTIONS ON THE PERMISSIBILITY OF CERTAIN
102 DOCUMENTS USED TO DEFINE IDENTIFICATION FOR
103 ELECTION-RELATED PURPOSES.

Bill Summary

Current law permits an eligible elector to use a variety of documents, some of which are not government-issued or do not contain a photograph of the elector, as identification for election-related purposes. The bill eliminates as permissible forms of identification for such

purposes a copy of a current utility bill, bank statement, government check, paycheck, or other government document that shows the name and address of the elector.

1 *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:*

2 **SECTION 1.** 1-1-104 (19.5) (a) (II) and (19.5) (a) (VII),
3 Colorado Revised Statutes, are amended to read:

4 **1-1-104. Definitions.** As used in this code, unless the context
5 otherwise requires:

7 (II) A valid identification card issued by the department of
8 revenue in accordance with ~~the requirements of part 3 of article 2 of title~~

13 **SECTION 2. Specified effective date.** This act shall take effect
14 July 1, 2010.

15 **SECTION 3. Safety clause.** The general assembly hereby finds,
16 determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate
17 preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
