### A BILL FOR AN ACT

101	CONCERNING A LIMIT ON THE AMOUNT OF GENERAL FUND
102	APPROPRIATIONS TO THE EXECUTIVE BRANCH FOR COSTS
103	ASSOCIATED WITH MEMBERSHIP TO PROFESSIONAL
104	ORGANIZATIONS.

#### **Bill Summary**

(Note: This summary applies to this bill as introduced and does not reflect any amendments that may be subsequently adopted. For the 2013-14 fiscal year and each fiscal year thereafter, the bill prohibits the general assembly from appropriating more than \$2 million

to the executive branch of government for use by the governor or by any executive department to pay the costs associated with membership to certain professional organizations.

On January 1, 2014, the bill requires the state treasurer to deduct an amount equal to the total reduction in general fund appropriations for membership to professional organizations and transfer such sum to the state education fund. The treasurer is required to deduct and transfer the same amount to the state education fund annually.

1 Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:

SECTION 1. In Colorado Revised Statutes, add 24-75-222 as
 follows:

4 24-75-222. General fund - appropriation limit - executive 5 branch membership organizations. (1) FOR THE 2013-14 FISCAL YEAR 6 AND EACH FISCAL YEAR THEREAFTER, THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY SHALL NOT 7 APPROPRIATE MORE THAN TWO MILLION DOLLARS TO THE EXECUTIVE 8 BRANCH OF GOVERNMENT FOR USE BY THE GOVERNOR OR BY ANY 9 EXECUTIVE DEPARTMENT TO PAY THE COSTS ASSOCIATED WITH 10 MEMBERSHIPS TO PROFESSIONAL, SUBJECT MATTER, TRADE, OR OTHER 11 ORGANIZATIONS.

12 (2) (a) ON JANUARY 1, 2014, THE STATE TREASURER SHALL 13 DEDUCT AN AMOUNT EQUAL TO THE TOTAL REDUCTION IN GENERAL FUND 14 APPROPRIATIONS REQUIRED BY SUBSECTION (1) OF THIS SECTION FROM THE 15 GENERAL FUND AND TRANSFER SUCH SUM TO THE STATE EDUCATION FUND 16 CREATED IN SECTION 17 (4) OF ARTICLE IX OF THE STATE CONSTITUTION. 17 (b) ON JANUARY 1, 2015, AND ON EACH JANUARY 1 THEREAFTER, 18 THE STATE TREASURER SHALL DEDUCT AN AMOUNT EQUAL TO THE 19 AMOUNT TRANSFERRED TO THE STATE EDUCATION FUND ON JANUARY 1, 20 2014, FROM THE GENERAL FUND PURSUANT TO PARAGRAPH (a) OF THIS 21 SUBSECTION (2), AND TRANSFER SUCH AMOUNT TO THE STATE EDUCATION

## 1 FUND.

SECTION 2. Safety clause. The general assembly hereby finds,
determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate
preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
