A BILL FOR AN ACT

101 CONCERNING THE REGISTRATION OF A VEHICLE USED FOR
102 AGRICULTURAL PRODUCTION.

Bill Summary

(Note: This summary applies to this bill as introduced and does not reflect any amendments that may be subsequently adopted. Currently, a county clerk may require that a person demonstrate that the person's primary business is agriculture to register a motor vehicle as a farm truck. The bill exempts people who use at least 100 acres for agricultural production from this requirement to register a farm truck.

1 *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:*

2 **SECTION 1.** 42-3-305 (4), Colorado Revised Statutes, is
3 amended BY THE ADDITION OF A NEW PARAGRAPH to read:

4 **42-3-305. Registration fees - passenger and passenger-mile**
5 **taxes - fee schedule for years of TABOR surplus revenue -**
6 **applicability.** (4) (e) NEITHER THE DEPARTMENT NOR AN AUTHORIZED
7 AGENT SHALL REQUIRE A PERSON REGISTERING A FARM TRUCK UNDER THIS
8 SUBSECTION (4) TO DEMONSTRATE THAT THE OWNER'S PRIMARY BUSINESS
9 OR SOURCE OF INCOME IS AGRICULTURE IF THE FARM TRUCK IS USED
10 PRIMARILY FOR AGRICULTURAL PRODUCTION ON A FARM OR RANCH OF AT
11 LEAST ONE HUNDRED ACRES.

12 **SECTION 2.** 42-3-306 (4), Colorado Revised Statutes, is
13 amended BY THE ADDITION OF A NEW PARAGRAPH to read:

14 **42-3-306. Registration fees - passenger and passenger-mile**
15 **taxes - fee schedule for years in which TABOR surplus revenue is**
16 **insufficient.** (4) (e) NEITHER THE DEPARTMENT NOR AN AUTHORIZED
17 AGENT SHALL REQUIRE A PERSON REGISTERING A FARM TRUCK UNDER THIS
18 SUBSECTION (4) TO DEMONSTRATE THAT THE OWNER'S PRIMARY BUSINESS
19 OR SOURCE OF INCOME IS AGRICULTURE IF THE FARM TRUCK IS USED
20 PRIMARILY FOR AGRICULTURAL PRODUCTION ON A FARM OR RANCH OF AT
21 LEAST ONE HUNDRED ACRES.

22 **SECTION 3. Act subject to petition - effective date.** This act
23 shall take effect at 12:01 a.m. on the day following the expiration of the
24 ninety-day period after final adjournment of the general assembly (August
25 11, 2010, if adjournment sine die is on May 12, 2010); except that, if a
26 referendum petition is filed pursuant to section 1 (3) of article V of the

1 state constitution against this act or an item, section, or part of this act
2 within such period, then the act, item, section, or part shall not take effect
3 unless approved by the people at the general election to be held in
4 November 2010 and shall take effect on the date of the official
5 declaration of the vote thereon by the governor.
