A BILL FOR AN ACT

CONCERNING A REQUIREMENT THAT VOTERS REGISTERING TO VOTE

IMMEDIATELY PRIOR TO OR ON ELECTION DAY PROVIDE A FORM

OF IDENTIFICATION THAT SHOWS A PHOTOGRAPH OF THE

VOTER.

### **Bill Summary**

In connection with current procedures permitting an elector to register to vote on or immediately prior to election day, the bill permits an elector to register to vote less than 29 days prior to or on election day

if the elector provides one of several enumerated forms of photo identification.

If enacted, the bill would be submitted to the electors of the state of Colorado for their approval or rejection under the referendum powers of the state constitution.

1 Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado: 2 **SECTION 1.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 1-2-217.7, add (4) 3 (a.5) as follows: 4 1-2-217.7. Registration on or immediately prior to election day 5 - locations - photo identification - rules - legislative declaration. 6 (4) Registration at voter service and polling centers. (a.5) AN 7 ELECTOR MAY REGISTER TO VOTE PRIOR TO AN ELECTION OR ON ELECTION 8 DAY AS PERMITTED BY THIS SECTION IF THE ELECTOR, IN ADDITION TO 9 SATISFYING ALL OTHER APPLICABLE REQUIREMENTS OF THIS SECTION, 10 PROVIDES ONE OF THE FOLLOWING FORMS OF IDENTIFICATION: 11 (I) A VALID COLORADO DRIVER'S LICENSE; 12 (II) A VALID IDENTIFICATION CARD ISSUED BY THE DEPARTMENT 13 OF REVENUE IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE REQUIREMENTS OF PART 3 OF 14 ARTICLE 2 OF TITLE 42, C.R.S.; 15 (III) A VALID UNITED STATES PASSPORT; 16 (IV) A VALID EMPLOYEE IDENTIFICATION CARD THAT SHOWS A 17 PHOTOGRAPH OF THE ELIGIBLE ELECTOR ISSUED BY ANY BRANCH, 18 DEPARTMENT, AGENCY, OR ENTITY OF THE UNITED STATES GOVERNMENT 19 OR OF THIS STATE, OR BY ANY COUNTY, MUNICIPALITY, BOARD, 20 AUTHORITY, OR OTHER POLITICAL SUBDIVISION OF THIS STATE; 21 (V) A VALID PILOT'S LICENSE ISSUED BY THE FEDERAL AVIATION 22 ADMINISTRATION OR OTHER AUTHORIZED AGENCY OF THE UNITED STATES; 23 (VI) A VALID UNITED STATES MILITARY IDENTIFICATION CARD

9	ELECTOR; OR
10	(IX) A VALID IDENTIFICATION CARD THAT SHOWS A PHOTOGRAPH
11	OF THE ELIGIBLE ELECTOR ISSUED BY A FEDERALLY RECOGNIZED TRIBAL
12	GOVERNMENT CERTIFYING TRIBAL MEMBERSHIP.
13	SECTION 2. Applicability. This act applies to any election
14	conducted on or after the date of the official declaration of the vote
15	thereon by proclamation of the governor.
16	SECTION 3. Refer to people under referendum. At the
17	election held on November 8, 2016, the secretary of state shall submit this
18	act by its ballot title to the registered electors of the state for their
19	approval or rejection. Each elector voting at the election may cast a vote
20	either "Yes/For" or "No/Against" on the following ballot title: "Shall
21	voters registering to vote immediately prior to or on election day provide
22	a form of identification that shows a photograph of the voter?" Except as
23	otherwise provided in section 1-40-123, Colorado Revised Statutes, if a
24	majority of the electors voting on the ballot title vote "Yes/For", then the
25	act will become part of the Colorado Revised Statutes.
