## A BILL FOR AN ACT

101 CONCERNING A CHANGE IN THE DATE BY WHICH A TAX INCREASE MUST

102 BE APPROVED FOR THE NEW "PUBLIC SCHOOL FINANCE ACT"

**103 TO BECOME EFFECTIVE.** 

#### **Bill Summary**

(Note: This summary applies to this bill as introduced and does not reflect any amendments that may be subsequently adopted. Under current law, the new "Public School Finance Act" (Act) and related statutory provisions take effect upon the proclamation of the governor of the vote cast at a statewide election approving an increase in tax revenues sufficient to fund the new Act and programs held no later than November 2017. The bill changes the date from 2017 to 2014.

1 Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado: 2 SECTION 1. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 22-54.5-106, amend 3 as it will take effect upon proclamation of the governor (1) as follows: 4 22-54.5-106. Effectiveness of article - applicability - rules. 5 (1) This article takes effect upon the proclamation by the governor of the 6 vote cast in a statewide election held no later than November 2017 2014 7 at which a majority of those voting approve a citizen-initiated increase in 8 state tax revenues for the purpose of funding preschool through twelfth 9 grade public education, so long as the amount of the approved revenue 10 increase is equal to or greater than the total estimated state fiscal impact 11 associated with the payment of the state share of total program pursuant 12 to section 22-54.5-203, investment moneys pursuant to section 13 22-54.5-301, hold-harmless moneys pursuant to section 22-54.5-302, and 14 per pupil supplemental payments pursuant to section 22-54.5-303, in the 15 second budget year commencing after the increase is approved, as stated 16 in the final fiscal note prepared for Senate Bill 13-213, enacted in 2013. 17 SECTION 2. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 22-30.5-111.5, 18 amend as it will take effect upon proclamation of the governor (17) 19 (a) as follows: 20 Charter schools - financing - definitions. 22-30.5-111.5. 21 (17) (a) This section takes effect upon the proclamation by the governor 22 of the vote cast in a statewide election held no later than November 2017 23 2014 at which a majority of those voting approve a citizen-initiated

increase in state tax revenues for the purpose of funding preschoolthrough twelfth grade public education, so long as the amount of the

1 approved revenue increase is equal to or greater than the total estimated 2 state fiscal impact associated with the payment of the state share of total 3 program pursuant to section 22-54.5-203, investment moneys pursuant 4 to section 22-54.5-301, hold-harmless moneys pursuant to section 5 22-54.5-302, and per pupil supplemental payments pursuant to section 6 22-54.5-303, in the second budget year commencing after the increase is 7 approved, as stated in the final fiscal note prepared for Senate Bill 8 13-213, enacted in 2013.

9 SECTION 3. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 22-30.5-111.7,
10 amend as it will take effect upon proclamation of the governor (5) (a)
11 as follows:

12 22-30.5-111.7. Financial reporting - request for accounting. 13 (5) (a) This section takes effect upon the proclamation by the governor 14 of the vote cast in a statewide election held no later than November  $\frac{2017}{2017}$ 15 2014 at which a majority of those voting approve a citizen-initiated 16 increase in state tax revenues for the purpose of funding preschool 17 through twelfth grade public education, so long as the amount of the 18 approved revenue increase is equal to or greater than the total estimated 19 state fiscal impact associated with the payment of the state share of total 20 program pursuant to section 22-54.5-203, investment moneys pursuant 21 to section 22-54.5-301, hold-harmless moneys pursuant to section 22 22-54.5-302, and per pupil supplemental payments pursuant to section 23 22-54.5-303, in the second budget year commencing after the increase is 24 approved, as stated in the final fiscal note prepared for Senate Bill 25 13-213, enacted in 2013.

SECTION 4. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 22-30.5-513.5,
 amend as it will take effect upon proclamation of the governor (11)

Institute charter schools - funding - definitions. 3 (11) (a) This section takes effect upon the proclamation by the governor 4 of the vote cast in a statewide election held no later than November <del>2017</del> 5 2014 at which a majority of those voting approve a citizen-initiated 6 increase in state tax revenues for the purpose of funding preschool 7 through twelfth grade public education, so long as the amount of the 8 approved revenue increase is equal to or greater than the total estimated 9 state fiscal impact associated with the payment of the state share of total 10 program pursuant to section 22-54.5-203, investment moneys pursuant 11 to section 22-54.5-301, hold-harmless moneys pursuant to section 12 22-54.5-302, and per pupil supplemental payments pursuant to section 13 22-54.5-303, in the second budget year commencing after the increase is 14 approved, as stated in the final fiscal note prepared for Senate Bill 15 13-213, enacted in 2013. 16 SECTION 5. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 22-28-104.1, amend

Establishment of public preschool programs. 20 (5) (a) This section takes effect upon the proclamation by the governor 21 of the vote cast in a statewide election held no later than November  $\frac{2017}{2017}$ 22 2014 at which a majority of those voting approve a citizen-initiated 23 increase in state tax revenues for the purpose of funding preschool 24 through twelfth grade public education, so long as the amount of the 25 approved revenue increase is equal to or greater than the total estimated 26 state fiscal impact associated with the payment of the state share of total 27 program pursuant to section 22-54.5-203, investment moneys pursuant to section 22-54.5-301, hold-harmless moneys pursuant to section
22-54.5-302, and per pupil supplemental payments pursuant to section
22-54.5-303, in the second budget year commencing after the increase is
approved, as stated in the final fiscal note prepared for Senate Bill
13-213, enacted in 2013.

6 SECTION 6. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 22-28-107.1, amend
7 as it will take effect upon proclamation of the governor (4) (a) as
8 follows:

9 22-28-107.1. District and institute charter school preschool 10 programs - plans. (4) (a) This section takes effect upon the 11 proclamation by the governor of the vote cast in a statewide election held 12 no later than November 2017 2014 at which a majority of those voting 13 approve a citizen-initiated increase in state tax revenues for the purpose 14 of funding preschool through twelfth grade public education, so long as 15 the amount of the approved revenue increase is equal to or greater than 16 the total estimated state fiscal impact associated with the payment of the 17 state share of total program pursuant to section 22-54.5-203, investment 18 moneys pursuant to section 22-54.5-301, hold-harmless moneys pursuant 19 to section 22-54.5-302, and per pupil supplemental payments pursuant to 20 section 22-54.5-303, in the second budget year commencing after the 21 increase is approved, as stated in the final fiscal note prepared for Senate 22 Bill 13-213, enacted in 2013.

23 SECTION 7. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 22-45-103, amend
 24 as it will take effect upon proclamation of the governor (1) (i) (II) (A)
 25 as follows:

26 22-45-103. Funds. (1) The following funds are created for each
27 school district for purposes specified in this article:

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1 (i) Technology and building maintenance and operation fund. 2 (II) (A) This paragraph (i) takes effect upon the proclamation by the 3 governor of the vote cast in a statewide election held no later than 4 November 2017 2014 at which a majority of those voting approve a 5 citizen-initiated increase in state tax revenues for the purpose of funding 6 preschool through twelfth grade public education, so long as the amount 7 of the approved revenue increase is equal to or greater than the total 8 estimated state fiscal impact associated with the payment of the state 9 share of total program pursuant to section 22-54.5-203, investment 10 moneys pursuant to section 22-54.5-301, hold-harmless moneys pursuant 11 to section 22-54.5-302, and per pupil supplemental payments pursuant to 12 section 22-54.5-303, in the second budget year commencing after the 13 increase is approved, as stated in the final fiscal note prepared for Senate

14 Bill 13-213, enacted in 2013.

# 15 SECTION 8. In Session Laws of Colorado 2013, section 15 of 16 chapter 248, amend (1) as follows:

17 Section 15. Effective date. (1) This act takes effect upon the 18 proclamation by the governor of the vote cast in a statewide election held 19 no later than November 2017 2014 at which a majority of those voting 20 approve a citizen-initiated increase in state tax revenues for the purpose 21 of funding preschool through twelfth grade public education, so long as 22 the amount of the approved revenue increase is equal to or greater than 23 the total estimated state fiscal impact associated with the payment of the 24 state share of total program pursuant to section 22-54.5-203, investment 25 moneys pursuant to section 22-54.5-301, hold-harmless moneys pursuant 26 to section 22-54.5-302, and per pupil supplemental payments pursuant to section 22-54.5-303, in the second budget year commencing after the 27

increase is approved, as stated in the final fiscal note prepared for Senate
 Bill 13-213, enacted in 2013.

3 SECTION 9. Act subject to petition - effective date. This act 4 takes effect at 12:01 a.m. on the day following the expiration of the ninety-day period after final adjournment of the general assembly (August 5 6 6, 2014, if adjournment sine die is on May 7, 2014); except that, if a 7 referendum petition is filed pursuant to section 1 (3) of article V of the 8 state constitution against this act or an item, section, or part of this act 9 within such period, then the act, item, section, or part will not take effect unless approved by the people at the general election to be held in 10 11 November 2014 and, in such case, will take effect on the date of the 12 official declaration of the vote thereon by the governor.
