Bill Summary

The bill requires that each mammography report provided to a patient include information that identifies the patient's breast tissue classification based on the breast imaging reporting and data system established by the American college of radiology. If the health care

Mammogram report - dense breasts - required 6 7 **notice - definition.** (1) EACH PERSON WHO IS REQUIRED BY 42 U.S.C. 8 SEC. 263b TO PROVIDE A PATIENT, THE PATIENT'S PHYSICIAN, OR MEDICAL 9 INSTITUTION WITH A MAMMOGRAM REPORT AND WHO HAS DETERMINED 10 THAT THE PATIENT HAS DENSE BREAST TISSUE, AS DETERMINED BY THE 11 INTERPRETING PHYSICIAN BASED ON STANDARDS PROMULGATED BY THE 12 AMERICAN COLLEGE OF RADIOLOGY, SHALL INCLUDE THE FOLLOWING 13 NOTICE WITH THE MAMMOGRAM REPORT: 14 YOUR MAMMOGRAM SHOWS THAT YOUR BREAST TISSUE IS 15 DENSE. DENSE BREAST TISSUE IS COMMON AND IS NOT 16 ABNORMAL. HOWEVER, DENSE BREAST TISSUE CAN MAKE IT 17 HARDER TO EVALUATE THE RESULTS OF YOUR MAMMOGRAM 18 AND MAY ALSO BE ASSOCIATED WITH AN INCREASED RISK OF 19 BREAST CANCER. THIS INFORMATION ABOUT THE RESULTS 20 OF YOUR MAMMOGRAM IS GIVEN TO YOU TO RAISE YOUR 21 AWARENESS AND TO INFORM YOUR CONVERSATIONS WITH YOUR HEALTH CARE PROVIDER.
