A BILL FOR AN ACT

101 **CONCERNING CLARIFYING RESTRICTIONS ON THE OPERATION OF**
102 **OFF-HIGHWAY VEHICLES.**

Bill Summary

The bill clarifies that it is unlawful to operate an off-highway vehicle on the public streets, roads, or highways of the state, regardless of the state or other jurisdiction in which the off-highway vehicle is registered or titled, except under certain existing exceptions.

1 *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:*

2 **SECTION 1.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 33-14.5-108, **amend**
3 (1) introductory portion as follows:

4 **33-14.5-108. Off-highway vehicle operation prohibited on**
5 **streets, roads, and highways.** (1) ~~NO~~ IT IS UNLAWFUL TO OPERATE AN
6 off-highway vehicle ~~may be operated~~ on the public streets, roads, or
7 highways of this state, REGARDLESS OF THE STATE OR OTHER JURISDICTION
8 IN WHICH THE OFF-HIGHWAY VEHICLE IS REGISTERED OR TITLED, **except in**
9 the following cases:

10 **SECTION 2. Applicability.** This act applies to conduct occurring
11 before, on, or after the effective date of this act.

12 **SECTION 3. Safety clause.** The general assembly hereby finds,
13 determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate
14 preservation of the public peace, health, or safety.
