A BILL FOR AN ACT

101 CONCERNING LIMITATIONS ON REGULATED MARIJUANA DELIVERY.

Bill Summary

(Note: This summary applies to this bill as introduced and does not reflect any amendments that may be subsequently adopted. If this bill passes third reading in the house of introduction, a bill summary that applies to the reengrossed version of this bill will be available at http://leg.colorado.gov.)

Under current law, a retail marijuana store licensee may have a marijuana delivery permit associated with its store license. The bill requires the store to be open at least 5 days a week and at least 5 hours a day to have a delivery permit. The bill limits delivery sales to only retail marijuana, retail marijuana products, or branded merchandise that is available for sale from the retail marijuana store and requires the prices to be the same as the in-store price. The bill prohibits an online platform from holding pre-paid accounts for a licensed retail marijuana store.

The bill waives the licensing fee for a transporter applicant who is a social equity licensee.

The bill prohibits a medical or retail marijuana business operator from engaging in the delivery of regulated marijuana.

1 *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:* 2 **SECTION 1.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 44-10-601, amend 3 (13)(a)(I) and (13)(f)(I) as follows: 4 44-10-601. Retail marijuana store license - rules - definitions. 5 (13) (a) (I) There is authorized a retail marijuana delivery permit to a 6 retail marijuana store license authorizing the permit holder to deliver 7 retail marijuana and retail marijuana products IF THE RETAIL MARIJUANA 8 STORE IS OPEN FOR AT LEAST FIVE DAYS A WEEK AND AT LEAST FIVE 9 HOURS A DAY. THE RETAIL MARIJUANA STORE MAY ONLY DELIVER RETAIL 10 MARIJUANA, RETAIL MARIJUANA PRODUCTS, OR BRANDED MERCHANDISE 11 THAT IS AVAILABLE FOR SALE FROM THE RETAIL MARIJUANA STORE AND 12 SHALL SELL THE ITEMS AT THE SAME PRICE AS THE PRICE FOR AN IN-STORE 13 PURCHASE. 14 (f) In accordance with this subsection (13) and rules adopted to 15 implement this subsection (13), a licensed retail marijuana store with a 16 valid retail marijuana delivery permit may: 17 (I) Receive an order through electronic or other means for the 18 purchase and delivery of retail marijuana or retail marijuana products. 19 When using an online platform for marijuana delivery, the platform must 20 require the individual to choose a retail marijuana store before viewing 21 the price; EXCEPT THAT AN ONLINE PLATFORM MUST NOT HOLD PRE-PAID 22 ACCOUNTS FOR A LICENSED RETAIL MARIJUANA STORE. 23 **SECTION 2.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 44-10-605, amend

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1	(1)(a) as follows:
2	44-10-605. Retail marijuana transporter license - definition.
3	(1) (a) A retail marijuana transporter license may be issued to a person
4	to provide logistics, distribution, delivery, and storage of retail marijuana
5	and retail marijuana products. Notwithstanding any other provisions of
6	law, a retail marijuana transporter license is valid for two years but cannot
7	be transferred with a change of ownership. A licensed retail marijuana
8	transporter is responsible for the retail marijuana and retail marijuana
9	products once it takes control of the product. THE STATE LICENSING
10	AUTHORITY SHALL WAIVE THE APPLICATION AND LICENSE FEE IF THE
11	PERSON APPLYING FOR THE TRANSPORTER LICENSE MEETS THE CRITERIA
12	ESTABLISHED PURSUANT TO SECTION 44-10-308 (4).
13	SECTION 3. In Colorado Revised Statutes, amend 44-10-506 as
14	follows:
15	44-10-506. Medical marijuana business operator license. A
16	medical marijuana business operator license may be issued to an entity or
17	person who operates a medical marijuana business licensed pursuant to
18	this article 10, for another medical marijuana business or retail marijuana
19	business licensed pursuant to this article 10, and who may receive a
20	portion of the profits as compensation. A MEDICAL MARIJUANA BUSINESS
21	OPERATOR SHALL NOT ENGAGE IN THE DELIVERY OF REGULATED
22	MARIJUANA.
23	SECTION 4. In Colorado Revised Statutes, amend 44-10-606 as
24	follows:
25	44-10-606. Retail marijuana business operator license. A retail
26	marijuana business operator license may be issued to a person who
27	operates a retail marijuana business licensed pursuant to this article 10,

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- for an owner licensed pursuant to this article 10, and who may receive a
 portion of the profits as compensation. A RETAIL MARIJUANA BUSINESS
 OPERATOR SHALL NOT ENGAGE IN THE DELIVERY OF REGULATED
 MARIJUANA.

 SECTION 5. Safety clause. The general assembly hereby finds,
 determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate
- 7 preservation of the public peace, health, or safety.

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
