Bill Summary

Sunset Process - House Local Government Committee. In 2004, the general assembly created the volunteer firefighter advisory committee (committee) to help develop a procedure for municipalities and districts to apply to the department of local affairs (DOLA) to receive state financial assistance in funding their pension plans. The committee was

also directed to consult with DOLA in connection with establishing a statewide accidental death and disability insurance policy for volunteer firefighters.

The bill repeals the committee, effective July 1, 2014.

1 Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado: 2 **SECTION 1.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 2-3-1203, repeal 3 (3) (aa) (III) as follows: 4 2-3-1203. Sunset review of advisory committees. (3) The 5 following dates are the dates for which the statutory authorization for the 6 designated advisory committees is scheduled for repeal: 7 (aa) July 1, 2014: 8 (III) The volunteer firefighter advisory committee, created in 9 section 31-30-1112 (6), C.R.S.; 10 **SECTION 2.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 31-30-1112, amend 11 (3) (a) and (4) (a); and **repeal** (6) as follows: 12 **31-30-1112.** State contributions - intent. (3) (a) The department 13 of local affairs shall work with the municipalities AND the districts and 14 the advisory committee established in subsection (6) of this section to 15 develop a procedure by which municipalities and districts apply to receive 16 state assistance moneys distributed pursuant to this section. Such THE 17 application procedure shall MUST ensure that the department can verify 18 the amount of money to which each municipality and district is entitled 19 before the department transfers funds to the municipalities and districts 20 each year. 21 (4) (a) The department of local affairs after consultation with the 22 advisory committee established in subsection (6) of this section, may

23 impose a nonrefundable application fee in an amount to be determined by

the department on any municipality or district that applies to the department for state assistance moneys distributed pursuant to this section. The application fee may be on a sliding scale based on the amount of state assistance moneys distributed to each fund pursuant to this section in the previous year.

6 (6) (a) There is hereby established a volunteer firefighter advisory 7 committee. The department of local affairs shall consult with the 8 committee in the performance of its duties in connection with the 9 distribution of state contribution moneys to municipal and district volunteer firefighter pension funds pursuant to this section and to the 10 11 accidental death and disability insurance policy for volunteer firefighters 12 pursuant to section 31-30-1134. The members of the advisory committee 13 shall not receive compensation or reimbursement from the state or the 14 department for expenses incurred in the performance of their duties. The 15 committee shall consist of five members that the executive director of the 16 department shall appoint as follows: three members shall be members of 17 a board, one member shall be an active volunteer firefighter, and one 18 member shall be a representative of a municipality or district that has 19 volunteer firefighters.

(b) This subsection (6) is repealed, effective July 1, 2014. Prior to
the repeal of this subsection (6), the advisory committee shall be reviewed
as provided for in section 2-3-1203, C.R.S.

SECTION 3. Effective date. This act takes effect July 1, 2014.
SECTION 4. Safety clause. The general assembly hereby finds,
determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate
preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
