

HOUSE BILL 16-1171

CONCERNING CONTINUATION OF THE COLORADO SPECIAL EDUCATION FISCAL ADVISORY COMMITTEE.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:

SECTION 1. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 22-20-114.5, amend (2) (c) as follows:

22-20-114.5. Special education fiscal advisory committee - special education high-cost grants - definitions. (2) (c) This subsection (2) is repealed, effective July 1, 2016: Prior to SEPTEMBER 1, 2021. BEFORE its repeal, the committee shall be reviewed as provided in IS SCHEDULED FOR REVIEW IN ACCORDANCE WITH section 2-3-1203, C.R.S.

SECTION 2. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 2-3-1203, repeal (3) (cc) (I); and add (3) (hh.5) (II) as follows:

2-3-1203. Sunset review of advisory committees. (3) The following dates are the dates on which the statutory authorization for the
