101	CONCERNING THE SUNSET REVIEW OF THE NATURAL AREAS COUNCIL
102	AND, IN CONNECTION THEREWITH, CONTINUING THE COUNCIL
103	INDEFINITELY.

Bill Summary

Sunset Process - House Agriculture, Livestock and Natural Resources Committee. The bill continues indefinitely the natural areas council, which serves as an advisory council to the parks and wildlife commission, in accordance with the recommendation of the department

of regulatory agencies contained in its sunset review of the council.

1	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:
2	SECTION 1. In Colorado Revised Statutes, repeal 33-33-113 as
3	follows:
4	33-33-113. Legislative review - termination. (1) The council
5	shall be terminated on July 1, 2014, unless the general assembly votes to
6	renew the legislative mandate of this article. Absent a vote to renew the
7	legislative mandate of this article, the council shall cease all operations
8	within a twelve-month period after July 1, 2014.
9	(2) Prior to said termination, such advisory committee shall be
10	reviewed as provided for in section 2-3-1203, C.R.S.
11	SECTION 2. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 2-3-1203, repeal (3)
12	(aa) (II) as follows:
13	2-3-1203. Sunset review of advisory committees. (3) The
14	following dates are the dates for which the statutory authorization for the
15	designated advisory committees is scheduled for repeal:
16	(aa) July 1, 2014:
17	(II) The Colorado natural areas council, an advisory council to the
18	parks and wildlife commission, appointed pursuant to section 33-33-106,
19	C.R.S.;
20	SECTION 3. Effective date. This act takes effect July 1, 2014.
21	SECTION 4. Safety clause. The general assembly hereby finds,
22	determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate
23	preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
