Sunset Process - House Energy and Environment Committee. The bill implements the recommendations in the department of regulatory







agencies' 2021 sunset report on the Colorado resiliency office in the department of local affairs by continuing the office for another 15 years, until 2037.

2	SECTION 1. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 24-32-121, amend
3	(2) as follows:
4	24-32-121. Colorado resiliency office - creation - director -
5	repeal. (2) This section is repealed, effective September 1, 2022
6	SEPTEMBER 1, 2037. Before its repeal, the Colorado resiliency office is
7	scheduled for review in accordance with section 24-34-104.
8	SECTION 2. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 24-32-122, amend
9	(6) as follows:
10	24-32-122. Colorado resiliency office - duties and powers -
11	repeal. (6) This section is repealed, effective September 1, 2022
12	SEPTEMBER 1, 2037. Before its repeal, this section is scheduled for review
13	in accordance with section 24-34-104.
14	SECTION 3. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 24-34-104, add (38)
15	as follows:
16	24-34-104. General assembly review of regulatory agencies
17	and functions for repeal, continuation, or reestablishment - legislative
18	declaration - repeal. (38) (a) THE FOLLOWING AGENCIES, FUNCTIONS, OR
19	BOTH, ARE SCHEDULED FOR REPEAL ON SEPTEMBER 1, 2037:
20	(I) THE COLORADO RESILIENCY OFFICE CREATED IN SECTION
21	24-32-121 and the functions of the office described in section
22	24-32-122.
23	(b) This subsection (38) is repealed, effective September 1,
24	2039.

SECTION 4. Act subject to petition - effective date. This act 1 2 takes effect at 12:01 a.m. on the day following the expiration of the 3 ninety-day period after final adjournment of the general assembly; except 4 that, if a referendum petition is filed pursuant to section 1 (3) of article V 5 of the state constitution against this act or an item, section, or part of this 6 act within such period, then the act, item, section, or part will not take 7 effect unless approved by the people at the general election to be held in 8 November 2022 and, in such case, will take effect on the date of the official declaration of the vote thereon by the governor. 9
