8 as may be necessary, for allocation to the Colorado bureau of  
9 investigation, laboratory and investigative services, operating expenses,  
10 for contract services for testing of backlog evidence related to the  
11 implementation of this act. ANY MONEYS APPROPRIATED IN THIS SECTION  
12 NOT EXPENDED PRIOR TO JULY 1, 2014, ARE FURTHER APPROPRIATED TO  
13 THE DEPARTMENT FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING JULY 1, 2014, FOR THE  
14 SAME PURPOSES.

15           **SECTION 5. Safety clause.** The general assembly hereby finds,  
16 determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate  
17 preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
