A BILL FOR AN ACT

101 CONCERNING FEES COLLECTED BY THE STATE ENGINEER FOR REVIEW

102 OF DAM SAFETY.

Bill Summary

(Note: This summary applies to this bill as introduced and does not reflect any amendments that may be subsequently adopted. Legislative Audit Committee. The bill increases the fee that the state engineer collects with regard to dam project design review. The fee collected for the examination and filing of each set of plans and specifications required to be filed with the state engineer for a proposed dam project is increased from \$3 for each \$1,000 of the estimated cost of the proposed project to \$6 for each \$1,000 of the estimated cost of the

proposed project, with the maximum fee raised from \$3,000 to \$30,000.

The bill adds a fee of \$2,000 per year for the annual inspection required of a dam against which the state engineer has imposed storage restrictions. The state engineer cannot impose the fee in the first year that the dam has been put under storage restrictions. The state engineer may waive the fee in any year that the state engineer determines that the owner or operator has taken reasonable steps toward curing deficiencies.

1 Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado: 2 SECTION 1. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 37-80-110, amend 3 (1) introductory portion and (1) (e); and **add** (1) (j) as follows: 4 **37-80-110. Fees collected by state engineer.** (1) Fees THE STATE 5 ENGINEER shall be collected by the state engineer COLLECT FEES for work 6 done in his OR HER office as follows: 7 (e) WITH RESPECT TO A PROPOSED PROJECT FOR A DAM, for the 8 examination and filing of each set of plans and specifications required by 9 law to be filed in the office of the state engineer, three SIX dollars for each 10 one thousand dollars or fraction thereof of the estimated cost thereof OF 11 A PROPOSED PROJECT; but the total amount of fees for examination and 12 filing of each set of plans and specifications shall MUST not be less than 13 one hundred dollars nor more than three THIRTY thousand dollars; 14 (i) (I) FOR DAMS AGAINST WHICH THE STATE ENGINEER HAS 15 IMPOSED STORAGE RESTRICTIONS UNDER SECTION 37-87-107 AND FOR 16 WHICH THE REQUIREMENT TO ANNUALLY INSPECT THE DAM RESULTS IN AN 17 INSPECTION THAT IS IN ADDITION TO THE REGULAR INSPECTION SCHEDULE, 18 TWO THOUSAND DOLLARS PER YEAR FOR THE ANNUAL DAM SAFETY 19 INSPECTION CONDUCTED BY THE STATE ENGINEER, TO BE PAID BY THE 20 OWNER OR OPERATOR OF THE DAM TO THE DIVISION OF WATER 21 **RESOURCES.** 22

(II) THE STATE ENGINEER SHALL NOT IMPOSE THE FEE DESCRIBED

1 IN SUBPARAGRAPH (I) OF THIS PARAGRAPH (j) UNTIL THE DAM HAS 2 REACHED ITS SECOND YEAR OF STORAGE RESTRICTIONS. THE STATE 3 ENGINEER MAY WAIVE THE FEE IN ANY YEAR IF THE STATE ENGINEER 4 DETERMINES THAT THE OWNER OR OPERATOR HAS TAKEN REASONABLE 5 STEPS TOWARD CURING THE DEFICIENCIES THAT LED TO THE STORAGE 6 RESTRICTION. WAIVER OF THE FEE UNDER THIS SUBPARAGRAPH (II) DOES 7 NOT PREVENT THE STATE ENGINEER FROM IMPOSING THE FEE IN A 8 SUBSEQUENT YEAR.

9 **SECTION 2.** Act subject to petition - effective date. This act 10 takes effect at 12:01 a.m. on the day following the expiration of the 11 ninety-day period after final adjournment of the general assembly 12 (August 5, 2015, if adjournment sine die is on May 6, 2015); except that, 13 if a referendum petition is filed pursuant to section 1 (3) of article V of 14 the state constitution against this act or an item, section, or part of this act 15 within such period, then the act, item, section, or part will not take effect 16 unless approved by the people at the general election to be held in 17 November 2016 and, in such case, will take effect on the date of the 18 official declaration of the vote thereon by the governor.
