A BILL FOR AN ACT

101	CONCERNING THE FUNDING OF COLORADO WATER CONSERVATION
102	BOARD PROJECTS, AND MAKING APPROPRIATIONS IN
103	CONNECTION THEREWITH.

Bill Summary

(Note: This summary applies to this bill as introduced and does not reflect any amendments that may be subsequently adopted. The bill appropriates the following amounts from the Colorado water conservation board construction fund for the following projects:

> \$250,000 for continuation of satellite monitoring system maintenance;

- ! \$50,000 for instream flow engineering and technical support services;
- ! \$175,000 for continuation of the weather modification program;
- ! \$500,000 for continuation of the Colorado floodplain map modernization program;
- ! \$250,000 for continuation of the watershed restoration program; and
- ! Up to \$300,000 to restore the unencumbered balance in the flood response fund to \$300,000.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:

SECTION 1. Continuation of the satellite monitoring system maintenance - appropriation. (1) In addition to any other appropriation, there is hereby appropriated, out of any moneys in the Colorado water conservation board construction fund not otherwise appropriated, to the department of natural resources, for allocation to the division of water resources, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2010, the sum of two hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$250,000), or so much thereof as may be necessary, for renovation of existing gauging stations, replacement of outdated collection platforms, and upgrading of transmission components of the satellite monitoring system established and operated pursuant to section 37-80-102 (10), Colorado Revised Statutes, stream gauge flood hardening projects, and data collection efforts related to flood forecasting and warning.

(2) The moneys appropriated in subsection (1) of this section shall remain available for the designated purposes until they are fully expended.

SECTION 2. Instream flow engineering and technical support services - appropriation. (1) In addition to any other appropriation, there is hereby appropriated, out of any moneys in the Colorado water

conservation board construction fund not otherwise appropriated, to the department of natural resources, for allocation to the Colorado water conservation board, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2010, the sum of fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000), or so much thereof as may be necessary, for engineering and technical support services related to the board's instream flow and natural lake level program.

(2) The moneys appropriated in subsection (1) of this section shall remain available for the designated purposes until they are fully expended.

SECTION 3. Continuation of the weather modification program - appropriation. (1) In addition to any other appropriation, there is hereby appropriated, out of any moneys in the Colorado water conservation board construction fund not otherwise appropriated, to the department of natural resources, for allocation to the Colorado water conservation board, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2010, the sum of one hundred seventy-five thousand dollars (\$175,000), or so much thereof as may be necessary, for the board to continue to assist water conservation districts, water conservancy districts, and other water providers with the development of cloud seeding programs that provide benefits to recreation, streams, and reservoirs through snowpack enhancement.

(2) The moneys appropriated in subsection (1) of this section shall remain available for the designated purposes until they are fully expended.

SECTION 4. Continuation of the Colorado floodplain map modernization program - appropriation. (1) In addition to any other appropriation, there is hereby appropriated, out of any moneys in the

Colorado water conservation board construction fund not otherwise appropriated, to the department of natural resources, for allocation to the Colorado water conservation board, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2010, the sum of five hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000), or so much thereof as may be necessary, to restore the unencumbered balance in the previously appropriated map modernization account of the board to five hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000), for the board to continue to assist with the preparation of revised and improved floodplain studies and maps for communities throughout Colorado and participate in federally sponsored floodplain map modernization activities.

(2) The moneys appropriated in subsection (1) of this section shall remain available for the designated purposes until the project is completed.

SECTION 5. Continuation of the watershed restoration program - appropriation. (1) In addition to any other appropriation, there is hereby appropriated, out of any moneys in the Colorado water conservation board construction fund not otherwise appropriated, to the department of natural resources, for allocation to the Colorado water conservation board, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2010, the sum of two hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$250,000), or so much thereof as may be necessary, for the board to continue to provide planning and engineering studies, including implementation measures, to address technical needs for watershed restoration and flood mitigation projects throughout the state.

(2) The moneys appropriated in subsection (1) of this section shall remain available for the designated purposes until they are fully expended.

1	SECTION 6. Restoration of flood response fund balance. The
2	state treasurer shall transfer a total of three hundred thousand dollars
3	(\$300,000), or so much thereof as may be necessary, from the unreserved
4	cash in the Colorado water conservation board construction fund to the
5	flood response fund created in section 37-60-123.2, Colorado Revised
6	Statutes, in order to restore the unencumbered balance in the flood
7	response fund to three hundred thousand dollars (\$300,000).
8	SECTION 7. 39-29-109 (2) (a), Colorado Revised Statutes, is
9	amended BY THE ADDITION OF A NEW SUBPARAGRAPH to read:
10	39-29-109. Severance tax trust fund - created - administration
11	- distribution of moneys - repeal. (2) State severance tax receipts shall
12	be credited to the severance tax trust fund as provided in section
13	39-29-108. Except as otherwise set forth in section 39-29-109.5, all
14	income derived from the deposit and investment of the moneys in the
15	fund shall be credited to the fund. At the end of any fiscal year, all
16	unexpended and unencumbered moneys in the fund shall remain therein

15	as may be necessary, for the purchase of all or a portion of Colorado's
16	allotment of Animas-La Plata project water pursuant to section 39-29-109
17	(2) (a) (VI) (B), Colorado Revised Statutes.
18	(2) The moneys appropriated in subsection (1) of this section shall
19	remain available for the designated purposes until they are fully
20	expended, or until June 30, 2015, whichever occurs first.
21	SECTION 9. Safety clause. The general assembly hereby finds,
22	determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate
23	preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
