A BILL FOR AN ACT

101 CONCERNING SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAMS FOR PERSONS IN INDUSTRIES

102 IN HIGH NEED OF TRAINED WORKFORCES.

Bill Summary

(Note: This summary applies to this bill as introduced and does not reflect any amendments that may be subsequently adopted. If this bill passes third reading in the house of introduction, a bill summary that applies to the reengrossed version of this bill will be available at http://www.leg.state.co.us/billsummaries.)

The bill creates the Colorado green jobs scholarship program (green jobs scholarship program) to assist persons in obtaining training or education for a job in an environmentally friendly growth industry and the Colorado medical services job training scholarship program (medical services scholarship program) to assist persons in obtaining training or education for a job in the medical services industry. The programs shall be implemented and administered through collegeinvest in the department of higher education. In awarding scholarships in both programs, collegeinvest will give priority to applicants who are unemployed or who demonstrate financial need.

On or before July 1, 2010, the governor's energy office will provide to collegeinvest a list of environmentally friendly growth industries to use in awarding scholarships pursuant to the green jobs scholarship program.

The collegeinvest board of directors (board) shall adopt policies to implement and administer the scholarship programs.

A scholarship recipient may use the scholarship toward a skilled trades apprenticeship program or to attend courses and programs at institutions of higher education, including public universities, community colleges, junior colleges, public occupational education schools, and nonpublic institutions of higher education.

Collegeinvest shall award and pay a minimum of:

- ! \$500,000 in scholarships pursuant to the 4-year green jobs scholarship program; and
- ! \$1 million in scholarships pursuant to the 4-year medical services scholarship program.

The moneys used to pay scholarships shall be from one transfer each to the green jobs scholarship fund and the medical services scholarship fund from the collegeinvest scholarship trust fund and from gifts, grants, or donations. Scholarships shall not be funded from general fund appropriations.

Collegeinvest shall report to the general assembly in 2011, 2012, 2013, and 2014 concerning the scholarships awarded.

The bill creates separate funds for the green jobs scholarship and medical services scholarship programs.

The green jobs scholarship and medical services scholarship programs are repealed, effective July 1, 2014.

SERVICES JOB TRAINING SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM, REFERRED TO IN THIS
SECTION AS THE "MEDICAL SERVICES SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM", FOR THE
PURPOSE OF PROVIDING EDUCATIONAL OPPORTUNITIES AND INCREASED
ACCESS TO HIGHER EDUCATION FOR INDIVIDUALS WHO ARE INTERESTED IN
EMPLOYMENT IN MEDICAL SERVICES FIELDS.

27 (II) IN AWARDING SCHOLARSHIPS PURSUANT TO THE MEDICAL

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1 SERVICES SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM, THE AUTHORITY SHALL, AT A MINIMUM, 2 ENSURE THAT THE JOB TRAINING OR EDUCATION COURSES OR PROGRAM 3 FOR WHICH THE APPLICANT SEEKS A SCHOLARSHIP WILL ASSIST THE 4 APPLICANT IN ACHIEVING GAINFUL EMPLOYMENT IN A MEDICAL SERVICES 5 FIELD. IN AWARDING SCHOLARSHIPS, THE AUTHORITY SHALL GIVE 6 PRIORITY TO APPLICANTS WHO ARE UNEMPLOYED OR WHO DEMONSTRATE 7 FINANCIAL NEED THROUGH ELIGIBILITY FOR THE FEDERAL PELL GRANT OR 8 ITS SUCCESSOR PROGRAM.
