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# A BILL FOR AN ACT CONCERNING REQUIRING THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION TO PREPARE AN ANNUAL REPORT RELATING TO THE TOTAL NUMBER OF SCHOOL PSYCHOLOGISTS LICENSED AND EMPLOYED BY A SCHOOL DISTRICT, AND, IN CONNECTION THEREWITH, MAKING AN APPROPRIATION.

schools in the state, and the total number of licensed school psychologists in the state and employed by a school district, a board of cooperative services, or the state charter school institute who are reported as full-time equivalent employees. The report must state the number of pupils and licensed and employed school psychologists in total for the state and disaggregated by school district, board of cooperative services, and the state charter school institute.

The bill requires the department to make the report publicly available on its website no later than 30 days after its completion.

8	SECTION 3. Safety clause. The general assembly hereby finds,
9	determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate
10	preservation of the public peace, health, or safety.

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
