A BILL FOR AN ACT

101 CONCERNING GIVING PEOPLE WITH DISABILITIES THE OPTION TO

102 PLACE A SYMBOL DOCUMENTING THE DISABILITY ON THE FACE

103 OF CERTAIN IDENTIFICATION DOCUMENTS.

Bill Summary

(Note: This summary applies to this bill as introduced and does not reflect any amendments that may be subsequently adopted. If this bill passes third reading in the house of introduction, a bill summary that applies to the reengrossed version of this bill will be available at <u>http://leg.colorado.gov</u>.)

The bill adds an option for people with disabilities to place a discreet disability identifier symbol on the face of a driver's license or identification card. A listed medical professional must verify the disability by signing a form created by the department of revenue. The symbol must represent all types of disabilities, such as cognitive, neurological, or physical disabilities. No fee is charged for the symbol.

(A) The registrant's social security number; OR

7 (B) THE REGISTRANT'S DISABILITY STATUS OR SYMBOL GIVEN 8 UNDER SUBSECTION (6) OF THIS SECTION.

9 (6) (a) (I) AT THE APPLICANT'S VOLUNTARY REQUEST, THE 10 DEPARTMENT SHALL ISSUE AN IDENTIFICATION CARD BEARING A 11 DISABILITY IDENTIFIER SYMBOL IF THE APPLICANT PRESENTS A FORM 12 SIGNED BY ONE OF THE FOLLOWING VERIFYING THAT THE APPLICANT HAS 13 A DISABILITY, INCLUDING CHRONIC ILLNESS OR PAIN:

9 PROFESSIONALS LISTED IN SUBSECTION (6)(a)(I) OF THIS SECTION TO
10 VERIFY THAT THE APPLICANT HAS A DISABILITY.

11 SECTION 3. Act subject to petition - effective date. This act 12 takes effect at 12:01 a.m. on the day following the expiration of the 13 ninety-day period after final adjournment of the general assembly (August 14 2, 2019, if adjournment sine die is on May 3, 2019); except that, if a 15 referendum petition is filed pursuant to section 1 (3) of article V of the 16 state constitution against this act or an item, section, or part of this act 17 within such period, then the act, item, section, or part will not take effect 18 unless approved by the people at the general election to be held in 19 November 2020 and, in such case, will take effect on the date of the 20 official declaration of the vote thereon by the governor.
