2 **SECTION 1.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 42-6-102, **repeal** (17)

3 (c) as follows:

4 **42-6-102. Definitions.** As used in this part 1, unless the context

8 **SECTION 2. Safety clause.** The general assembly hereby finds,  
9 determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate  
10 preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
