CONCERNING A CLARIFICATION OF THE DEFINITION OF VETERINARY PREMISES IN THE "COLORADO VETERINARY PRACTICE ACT".

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:*

**SECTION 1.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 12-64-103, **amend** (17) as follows:

**12-64-103. Definitions.** As used in this article, unless the context otherwise requires:

(17) "Veterinary premises" or "premises" means ~~any~~ A veterinary office, hospital, clinic, or temporary location in which veterinary medicine is being practiced by or ~~under the direct or immediate supervision~~ UNDER THE DIRECTION AND SUPERVISION of a licensed veterinarian.

**SECTION 2. Safety clause.** The general assembly hereby finds,

determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
