

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:

SECTION 1. In Colorado Revised Statutes, **amend** 38-38-808 as follows:

38-38-808. Repeal of part. This part 8 is repealed, effective June 30, 2014 SEPTEMBER 1, 2015.
