Bill Summary

Wholesale sales are not subject to sales and use taxes. The bill includes sales of fertilizer used in the production of agricultural and livestock products in the definition of "wholesale sales" for sales and use tax purposes.

10	SECTION 2. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 39-26-102, add
11	(19)(e), (19)(f), and (19)(g) as follows:

14	(19) (e) "Wholesale sale" includes sales of fertilizer for
15	USE IN THE PRODUCTION OF AGRICULTURAL COMMODITIES. FOR PURPOSES
16	OF THIS SUBSECTION (19)(e), "FERTILIZER" MEANS FERTILIZER AS DEFINED
17	IN SECTION 35-12-103 (12), BUT NOT INCLUDING SPECIALTY FERTILIZER AS
18	DEFINED IN SECTION 35-12-103 (30).
19	(f) "WHOLESALE SALE" INCLUDES SALES OF SPRAY ADJUVANTS FOR
20	USE IN THE PRODUCTION OF AGRICULTURAL COMMODITIES. FOR PURPOSES
21	OF THIS SUBSECTION (19)(f), "SPRAY ADJUVANTS" MEANS PRODUCTS THAT
22	ARE USED TO INCREASE THE EFFECTIVENESS OF A PESTICIDE.
