A BILL FOR AN ACT

101 CONCERNING THE CLOSURE OF THE SOUTH CAMPUS OF THE
102 CENTENNIAL CORRECTIONAL FACILITY FOR HOUSING PURPOSES.

Bill Summary

Joint Budget Committee Budget Package Bill. The bill closes the south campus of the Centennial correctional facility for inmate housing purposes but, if necessary, allows the south campus to be maintained to provide support and services to the rest of the Centennial correctional facility.

1 *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:*

2 **SECTION 1.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 17-1-104.3, **add** (1)
3 (b.5) as follows:

4 **17-1-104.3. Correctional facilities - locations - security level.**

5 (1) (b.5) NOTWITHSTANDING THE PROVISIONS OF PARAGRAPH (b) OF THIS
6 SUBSECTION (1), BEGINNING FEBRUARY 1, 2013, THE CENTENNIAL SOUTH
7 CAMPUS OF THE CENTENNIAL CORRECTIONAL FACILITY SHALL NOT BE
8 OPERATED BY THE DEPARTMENT FOR THE PURPOSE OF HOUSING INMATES
9 IN THE HOUSING UNITS BUT, IF NECESSARY, MAY BE MAINTAINED TO
10 PROVIDE SUPPORT AND OTHER SERVICES TO THE CENTENNIAL
11 CORRECTIONAL FACILITY. THE DEPARTMENT SHALL ACTIVELY PURSUE
12 OPTIONS TO SELL OR LEASE THE CENTENNIAL SOUTH CAMPUS OF THE
13 CENTENNIAL CORRECTIONAL FACILITY, WHICH IS ALSO KNOWN AS
14 COLORADO STATE PENITENTIARY II OR CSP II. ANY PROCEEDS RECEIVED
15 AS A RESULT OF A SALE OR LEASE OF CENTENNIAL SOUTH CAMPUS OF THE
16 CENTENNIAL CORRECTIONAL FACILITY SHALL BE FIRST APPLIED TO THE
17 PAYMENT OF THE CERTIFICATES OF PARTICIPATION.

18 **SECTION 2. Act subject to petition - effective date.** This act
19 takes effect at 12:01 a.m. on the day following the expiration of the
20 ninety-day period after final adjournment of the general assembly (August
21 8, 2012, if adjournment sine die is on May 9, 2012); except that, if a
22 referendum petition is filed pursuant to section 1 (3) of article V of the
23 state constitution against this act or an item, section, or part of this act
24 within such period, then the act, item, section, or part will not take effect
25 unless approved by the people at the general election to be held in

- 1 November 2012 and, in such case, will take effect on the date of the
- 2 official declaration of the vote thereon by the governor.
