A BILL FOR AN ACT

101 CONCERNING THE INNOVATIVE INDUSTRIES WORKFORCE
102 DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM, AND, IN CONNECTION THEREWITH,
103 EXTENDING THE PROGRAM FOR FIVE YEARS.

Bill Summary

The bill extends the repeal date of the innovative industries workforce development program for 5 years, until July 1, 2025. The bill also appropriates \$900,000 from the general fund to the division of employment and training in the department of labor and employment to be used for program reimbursements during the fiscal year beginning July

1 *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:*

2 **SECTION 1.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 24-46.3-105, **amend**
3 (5), (6), and (7) as follows:

4 **24-46.3-105. Innovative industries workforce development**
5 **program - legislative declaration - definitions - appropriation -**
6 **repeal.** (5) On or before ~~November 1, 2016~~ NOVEMBER 1, 2020, and
7 November 1 of the next two years thereafter, the state council shall
8 submit a report to the finance COMMITTEE and the business affairs and
9 labor ~~committees~~ COMMITTEE of the house of representatives and to the
10 business, labor, and technology COMMITTEE and the finance ~~committees~~
11 COMMITTEE of the senate, or any successor committees, summarizing
12 program activities during the preceding fiscal year, including the
13 information in ~~subparagraph (III) of paragraph (b) of subsection (3)~~
14 SUBSECTION (3)(b)(III) of this section, the number of companies and
15 interns who participated, the occupational areas IN WHICH the interns
16 participated, ~~in~~, the number of interns who obtained related employment,
17 and any information identified by the division ~~from~~ PURSUANT TO this
18 subsection (5). The division shall assist the state council in completing the
19 annual report.

20 (6) For the fiscal year beginning ~~on July 1, 2015~~ JULY 1, 2020, the
21 general assembly shall appropriate ~~four hundred fifty~~ NINE HUNDRED
22 thousand dollars from the general fund to the division to be used for
23 program reimbursements. For EACH OF the ~~next~~ two years thereafter, the
24 general assembly may appropriate ~~moneys~~ MONEY from the general fund
25 to the division to be used for program reimbursements. In addition, the

1 general assembly shall annually appropriate ~~moneys~~ MONEY from the
2 general fund to the department for its expenses administering the
3 program, including any payments to intermediaries. Any unexpended and
4 unencumbered ~~moneys~~ MONEY from an appropriation made pursuant to
5 this subsection (6) ~~remain~~ REMAINS available for expenditure by the
6 department in the next fiscal year without further appropriation.

7 (7) This section is repealed, effective ~~July 1, 2020~~ JULY 1, 2025.

8 **SECTION 2.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 8-83-103, **amend**
9 (3)(b) as follows:

10 **8-83-103. Powers, duties, and functions - acceptance of money**
11 **- repeal.** (3) (b) This subsection (3) is repealed, effective ~~July 1, 2020~~
12 JULY 1, 2025.

13 **SECTION 3. Act subject to petition - effective date.** This act
14 takes effect at 12:01 a.m. on the day following the expiration of the
15 ninety-day period after final adjournment of the general assembly (August
16 5, 2020, if adjournment sine die is on May 6, 2020); except that, if a
17 referendum petition is filed pursuant to section 1 (3) of article V of the
18 state constitution against this act or an item, section, or part of this act
19 within such period, then the act, item, section, or part will not take effect
20 unless approved by the people at the general election to be held in
21 November 2020 and, in such case, will take effect on the date of the
22 official declaration of the vote thereon by the governor.
