101 CONCERNING THE AUGMENTATION OF THE GENERAL FUND THROUGH 102 TRANSFERS OF CERTAIN MONEYS.

Bill Summary

Budget Package Bill. For the purpose of augmenting the amount of revenues in the state general fund for the 2010-11 state fiscal year, on June 30, 2011, the state treasurer is required to transfer specified amounts of moneys to the general fund from the following funds:
