Bill Summary

(Note: This summary applies to this bill as introduced and does not reflect any amendments that may be subsequently adopted. To engage in industrial hemp cultivation in the state, a person is required to apply to the department of agriculture for a registration. In applying for a registration, the person must include the names and addresses of all key participants in the registered activity. The bill amends the definition of "key participant" to include faculty at an institution of Reading Unamended May 2, 2022

higher education to align with federal law requirements that all individuals authorized to grow hemp under a registration undergo a criminal history record check.

1 *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:* 2 **SECTION 1.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 35-61-101, amend 3 (7.3) as follows: 4 **35-61-101. Definitions.** As used in this article 61, unless the 5 context otherwise requires: 6 (7.3) (a) "Key participant" means a sole proprietor, a partner in a 7 partnership, or a person with executive managerial control in a 8 corporation, OR FACULTY AT AN INSTITUTION OF HIGHER EDUCATION. A 9 person with executive managerial control includes persons such as a chief 10 executive officer, chief operating officer, or chief financial officer. 11 (b) "Key participant" does not include nonexecutive managers 12 such as farm, field, or shift managers. 13 **SECTION 2. Safety clause.** The general assembly hereby finds, 14 determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate 15 preservation of the public peace, health, or safety.
