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A BILL FOR AN ACT

101 CONCERNING THE TRANSFER OF MONEY FROM THE GENERAL FUND TO  
102 THE COLORADO CRIME VICTIM SERVICES FUND.

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**Bill Summary**

**Joint Budget Committee.** The bill requires the state treasurer to transfer \$4 million from the general fund to the Colorado crime victim services fund on July 1, 2024.

1           **SECTION 1.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 24-33.5-505.5,  
2   **amend** (2) as follows:

3           **24-33.5-505.5. Colorado crime victim services fund - creation**  
4   **- uses - applications for grants - legislative declaration - repeal.**

5   (2) (a) The Colorado crime victim services fund is created in the state  
6   treasury and referred to in this section as the "fund". The fund consists of  
7   money transferred to the fund pursuant to ~~subsection (4)~~ SUBSECTIONS  
8   (2)(b) AND (4) of this section and any other money that the general  
9   assembly may appropriate or transfer to the fund. Money in the fund is  
10   continuously appropriated to the division for crime victim services grants,  
11   as described in subsection (3) of this section.

12           (b) (I) ON JULY 1, 2024, THE STATE TREASURER SHALL TRANSFER  
13   FOUR MILLION DOLLARS FROM THE GENERAL FUND TO THE FUND.

14           (II) THIS SUBSECTION (2)(b) IS REPEALED, EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2025.

15           **SECTION 2. Safety clause.** The general assembly finds,  
16   determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate  
17   preservation of the public peace, health, or safety or for appropriations for  
18   the support and maintenance of the departments of the state and state  
19   institutions.
