CONCERNING A TECHNICAL CORRECTION TO A REFERENCE TO THE NUMBER OF MEMBERS SERVING ON THE STATE BOARD OF NURSING.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:

SECTION 1. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 12-255-119, **amend** (1)(a) as follows:

12-255-119. Disciplinary procedures of the board - inquiry and hearings panels - mental and physical examinations - definitions - rules. (1) (a) The president of the board shall divide the other ten members of the board into two panels of five members each. Members representing the different categories of membership (licensed practical nurses, professional nurses, certified midwives, and persons not licensed, employed, or in any way connected with, or with any financial interest in, any health-care facility, agency, or insurer) shall be divided between the two panels as equally as possible.

SECTION 2. Effective date. This act takes effect July 1, 2024.

SECTION 3. Safety clause. The general assembly finds, determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, or safety or for appropriations for the support and maintenance of the departments of the state and state institutions.
