12	WHEREAS, Pursuant to section 37-95-107.6 (4)(b), Colorado
13	Revised Statutes, the Commission has developed additions,
14	modifications, and deletions to the Water Pollution Control Project
15	Eligibility List; and
16	WHEREAS, Providing financial assistance from the DWRF and
17	the WPCRF to the proposed projects will preserve, protect, conserve, and
18	develop the water resources of the state; promote the beneficial use of the
19 20	waters of the state and the protection and preservation of the public health, safety, and welfare; create and preserve jobs and employment
21	opportunities; and improve the economic welfare of the people of the
22	state; and
