1	WHEREAS, Kendrick Castillo, the only child of John and Maria
2	Castillo, was born on March 14, 2001; and

WHEREAS, As a high school senior, Kendrick attended STEM School Highlands Ranch and served as a 4-year member of the school's robotics team, planned to study electrical engineering in college, and ultimately planned to serve his country as a United States Marine; and

7 WHEREAS, On May 7, 2019, Kendrick Castillo was in class at

- 2 WHEREAS, Kendrick Castillo acted fast and lunged at the 3 gunman, giving his classmates time to take cover; and
- WHEREAS, Kendrick Castillo was shot by the gunman and
 ultimately gave his life to save the lives of countless students that day;
 and
- WHEREAS, Kendrick was known to be friendly and modest,
 never saying an unkind word, and it was in his nature to help people; and
- 9 WHEREAS, Kendrick is widely regarded by citizens of the state10 of Colorado as a true hero; and
- WHEREAS, It is the purpose of this Joint Resolution to keep the
 memory of Kendrick Castillo alive so that generations of Coloradans can
 be inspired by Kendrick's selfless and heroic act; now, therefore,
- 14 Be It Resolved by the House of Representatives of the 15 Seventy-second General Assembly of the State of Colorado, the Senate 16 concurring herein:
- (1) That a portion of Colorado State Highway 470 from University
 Boulevard to Santa Fe Road be named the "Kendrick Castillo Memorial
 Highway" in honor of Kendrick's heroic sacrifice.
- (2) That the Colorado Department of Transportation may accept
 and expend gifts, grants, and donations for the purposes of the initial
 placement of signs to mark the designated section of Colorado State
 Highway 470 as the "Kendrick Castillo Memorial Highway".
- (3) That the Colorado Department of Transportation may explore
 a cooperative agreement with the Board of County Commissioners for
 Douglas County for the maintenance of signs marking the "Kendrick
 Castillo Memorial Highway".
- Be It Further Resolved, That copies of this Joint Resolution be sent
 to the Colorado Transportation Commission, the Office of Transportation
 Safety within the Colorado Department of Transportation, and John and
 Maria Castillo.
