CONCERNING RECOGNITION OF MILITARY, VETERANS, AND MIA/POW
APPRECIATION DAY.
WHEREAS, Colorado has a proud and distinguished history of
dedicated military service by men and women of this state whose courage,
heroism, and sacrifice preserve the liberties and democratic way of life set
forth in our state and federal constitutions; and
WHEREAS, Colorado is home to a significant number of military
installations, including Fort Carson, the United States Air Force
Academy, Buckley Air Force Base, Peterson Air Force Base, Schriever
Air Force Base, and Cheyenne Mountain Air Force Station, that
contribute not only to the national security of our nation but to the
economic health of our state; and
WHEREAS, Colorado benefits significantly from the presence and

1 2	military service of the more than 49,000 men and women in our state who serve in the United States Army, Navy, Air Force, Marine Corps, and
3	Coast Guard; the branch Reserves; the Colorado National Guard; and the Civil Air Patrol; and
5	WHEREAS, The men and women of the Colorado National Guard
6	have served in defense of our nation and as the first military responders
7 8	in support of civil authorities during domestic emergencies and are celebrating their 157th anniversary this year; and
9	WHEREAS, In times of conflict around the globe, it is particularly
10	appropriate to recognize the Coloradans in all branches and components
11 12	of the Armed Services who serve around the world to protect the security and peace of our nation and other nations; and
13	WHEREAS, In addition to active members of the Armed Services,
14	Colorado is the proud home of more than 412,000 military veterans who
15	have served their country long and well and who bring great honor and
16	distinction to the state; and
17	WHEREAS, Colorado is home not only to active duty service
18	personnel and veterans but also to the countless family members of these
19	men and women who display the same dedication, courage, and sacrifice;
20	and
21	WHEREAS, We should also never forget the sacrifices made for
22	us by the 94 men from Colorado declared missing in action or prisoners
23	of war while defending the principles of liberty and justice in conflicts in
24	Korea, Laos, and Vietnam; now, therefore,
25	Be It Resolved by the House of Representatives of the Seventy-first
26	General Assembly of the State of Colorado, the Senate concurring herein:
27	(1) That we, the members of the Seventy-first General Assembly,
28	hereby extend our heartfelt gratitude to our state's veterans, past and
29	present, to all military men and women currently serving in the Armed
30	Services, and to the family members of active duty personnel and veterans
31	and that we remember and honor those prisoners of war and those missing
32	in action from previous conflicts;
33	(2) That we express our continued partnership with and support
34	of Fort Carson and maintain our strong commitment to supporting
