1	WHEREAS, Thousands of military personnel from Colorado have
2	served around the world in the ongoing war against terrorism, including
3	troops based at Fort Carson, the United States Air Force Academy,
4	Peterson Air Force Base, and Buckley Air Force Base; members of the
5	Colorado National Guard, Army Reserve, and Marine Corps Reserve; and
6	troops from Colorado who are deployed with military units based in other
7	states; and
8	WHEREAS, On March 29, 2017, Staff Sergeant Austin Bieren,
9	25, of Umatilla, Oregon, a member of the United States Air Force

1	assigned to the 21st Space Wing, based at Peterson Air Force Base,
2 3	Colorado, made the ultimate sacrifice while serving his country in Operation Inherent Resolve; and
4	WHEREAS, On November 4, 2017, Sergeant First Class Stephen
5	B. Cribben, 33, of Fort Lee, New Jersey, a member of the United States
6	Army assigned to 2nd Battalion, 10th Special Forces Group (Airborne),
7	based at Fort Carson, Colorado, made the ultimate sacrifice while serving
8	his country in Operation Freedom's Sentinel; and
9	WHEREAS, On January 1, 2018, Sergeant First Class Mihail
10	Golin, 34, of Simi Valley, California, a member of the United States
11	Army assigned to 2nd Battalion, 10th Special Forces Group (Airborne),
12	based at Fort Carson, Colorado, made the ultimate sacrifice while serving
13	his country in Operation Freedom's Sentinel; and
14	Be It Resolved by the House of Representatives of the Seventy-first
15	General Assembly of the State of Colorado, the Senate concurring herein:
16	That we, the members of the Seventy-first General Assembly of
17	the state of Colorado:
18	(1) Remember and honor these and all Coloradans who have
