HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION 18-1010

101 CONCERNING RECOGNITION OF MILITARY PERSONNEL FROM
102 COLORADO WHO HAVE SERVED AROUND THE WORLD IN THE
103 ONGOING WAR AGAINST TERRORISM AND HONORING THOSE WHO
104 HAVE DIED WHILE SERVING THE CAUSE OF FREEDOM.

1 WHEREAS, Thousands of military personnel from Colorado have
2 served around the world in the ongoing war against terrorism, including
3 troops based at Fort Carson, the United States Air Force Academy,
4 Peterson Air Force Base, and Buckley Air Force Base; members of the
5 Colorado National Guard, Army Reserve, and Marine Corps Reserve; and
6 troops from Colorado who are deployed with military units based in other
7 states; and

8 WHEREAS, On March 29, 2017, Staff Sergeant Austin Bieren,
