	WHEREAS, All United States Armed Forces service members and	
	veterans past and present who have protected and defended and continue	
	to protect and defend the United States Constitution and our country	
	deserve gratitude and recognition regardless of race, gender, faith, or	
	ethnicity; and	
	WHEREAS, The military includes the Army, Navy, Marine Corps,	
	Air Force, Coast Guard, Space Force, and National Guard; this includes	
	over 1.3 million active duty personnel and around 19 million veterans in	
	support of democracy and the American Dream; and	

1	WHEREAS, United States service members have served and do
2	selflessly serve on the front lines, "at the tip of the spear" to protect our
3	country from enemies foreign and domestic; they stand shoulder to
4	shoulder as Americans defending and protecting the United States of
5	America from enemies foreign and domestic; and
6	WHEREAS, All United States service members, past and present,
